The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Correspondence.

Letters were read from the K.C.A. one notifying the Club of the Annual Association's Sports Day At Maidstone July, 14th. The other being a proposal that the present method of affiliation namely 6d. per member be discontinued, on the grounds that it caused unnecessary clerical work for the Association and Club Secretaries.

That a fixed affiliation fee per Club should be charged namely 10/-. It was proposed that the question should be brought before the next Association A.G.M.
