

Minutes of Meeting held at 5, St. Mary's Terrace,

Hastings, Thursday, July 25th. 1935.

Present. Mr. H. Smith in the Chair, supported by Messrs Bosting, A. Helliwell, Kemp, Griffin, Jenkins, Hughes, Lelyveld, the secretary and the treasurer.

Minutes. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Arising from the Minutes.

The secretary reported that he had accepted Messrs Butler quotation for the Radio, and that no advertising in the morning could be arranged as the van would be needed in the Grounds.

It was decided that there should be two sandwich men engaged to work during the Monday morning.

The secretary reported that he went to the Bexhill Police Sports, where he had displayed two posters in the competitors dressing rooms and issued forms to several of them, also that the Organising Secretary kindly arranged for an announcement during the programme, advertising our Sports.

Prizes. The prizes sub-committee reported that all the prizes had been purchased with the exception of those for the Tradesman's Race.

ADVERTISEMENTS. It was decided that there should be two 6/- insertions in the next two issues of the Observer. and an insertion in the Argus on Saturday, Aug. 3rd. not exceeding 12/-.

Town Crier. It was decided to engage the town crier as in last year for the sum of 8/- for the Monday morning.

Course Measurement. The secretary reported that the present '508 course was nearly 1400 yards short.

A discussion ensued as to the best method of making up this extra distance and it was finally decided that the riders should continue to the Coffee-stall corner at Hythe before turning instead of turning at the tree. This would add approximately 1000 yards to the course, the rest being made up by continuing at the finish, past T.P. 14 to a finish about T.P. 7.
