6. All questions as to starts shall be in the absolute discretion of the Starter.
7. Track Marking Cards:  
Cycling, Red; Athletics, White.

In order that spectators will be afforded an uninterrupted view of the sports, the arena will be kept as clear as possible. To assist in this matter, officials are requested not to congregate in the vicinity of the Starting and Finishing Posts, except as required by their official duties.

Officials only are permitted to remain inside the track. Competitors are requested to leave immediately at the conclusion of the event in which they are taking part. They are advised to make full use of the Competitors' Enclosure.
