### BEST ALL ROUNDER CHAMPIONSHIP

All Club, E.S.C.A. and K.C.A. events at 25, 50 100 miles and 12 hours will count for the B.A.R. championship, with the exception of evening events.

The closing date for Club racing entries is 7 days prior to the event. Fees—Senior : 1/6, Junior 1/-.
