IDDLESBROUGH WIN FOR WANLESS

RAHAM Wanless scored his first success this year for his new club, Ferry Wh., when he led a four-up finish in the 45-mile Middlesbrough Co-oping Criterion road race by a clear margin on Sunday. High winds swept across the course and on the first lap, riders broke away. Still together on the second lap they were depleted when Andy Anderson punctured, and when with 10 miles to go, John Paling crashed, finished sixth, after losing nearly a minute.

Of the four riders at the finish Wanless was the strongest of the quartette.

He was subsequently disqualified for an alleged pacing infringement, giving Halton the lead.
