G.50 Course Details

Start on A.267 just South of Hellingly Village Hall Traffic Island, proceed South along A.267 to Boship Roundabout, straight on along A.22 to just short of the end of Dual Carraigeway on Nightingale Hill, Polegate. TURN through connecting road and retrace to Boship Roundabout (6 $\frac{1}{2}$ mls), Left along A.22 to approx; 200yds short of Dicker Lounge Cafe, (between T/P"s Nos 21 & 22). TURN. Retrace to Boship Roundabout, Left along A.267 to Finish approx; 250yds short of Start.

G.52 Course Details.

Start on A.267 just South of Hellingly Village Hall Traffic Island, proceed South along A.267 to Boship Roundabout, straight on along A.22 to just short of end of Dual Carraigeway on Nightingale Hill, Polegate. TURN through connecting road & retrace to Boship Roundabout. (6 $\frac{1}{2}$ mls). Left along A.22 through Golden Cross, Whitesmith, East Hoathly & Halland to approx 200 yds beyond the Barley Mow Inn. ($\frac{3}{4}$ mile short of junction of A.22/A.26 at Union Point Uckfield. (15.65mls). TURN & Retrace to Boship Roundabout, LEFT along A.267 to Finish approx 250yds short of Start.
