COURSE

Start 1/4 mile up unclassified road north of Piltdown Common, signposted to Nutley.

Proceed to junction with B2102 and turn left to commence the circuit (end of neutralised section). Continue to Maresfield where left on A22 via Nutley to Wych Cross. Sharp left on A275 via Danehill to Chailey crossroads, where left to Newick and Piltdown, completing the 20-mile lap. Complete 2 laps and turn left into unclassified road to finish same place as start. Total distance 40 miles.

Race Control and H.Q. will be at the starting point.
