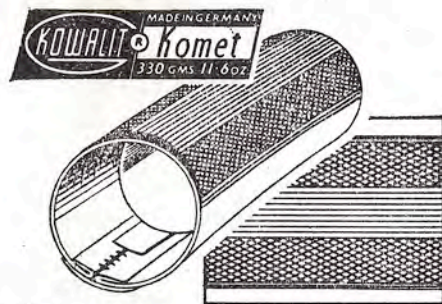

START on the A604 (Thrapston-Huntingdon Rd) at the eastern gatepost of the gateway opposite boundary to the car dealers field, BYTHORN (app. 200 yds east of milestone Thrapston 5) Proceed east towards Huntingdon through SPALDWICK to the 2nd cats-eye beyond 7th tree on the right-hand side after white house, approx. 200 yds east of milestone Thrapston 10.

TURN and retrace outward route to FINISH opposite start.
