

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

R.T.T.C. Regulations will be strictly enforced and particular attention is drawn to Reg's. 44 and 45 regarding unpaced riding and use of motor vehicles.

RIDERS before 6.01 a.m. will be required to use lights. These may be discarded at the feeding station in Pangbourne Lane (53 miles) and later collected at the Event H.Q.

KIT left at the Start will be transported to the H.Q. for collection after the event.

HALT SIGNS at East Hanney and Shillingford Cross Roads MUST be observed.

GREAT CARE at the Right Turns: Drayton, Wallingford Traffic Lights and Kennell Corner (crossing the Bath Road into the Burghfield Road).

NUMBER PLATES should be left with Timekeepers.
