About today's meeting

We are very pleased to welcome you to the Crystal Palace today for the third Mackeson Cycle Race Meeting. One big change this year—the event is being held on a Saturday, instead of a Sunday as before, and we hope this move will make the meeting even more popular with the cycle racing fans.

The last two Mackeson Meetings have produced some of the most exciting racing seen on the Crystal Palace circuit and anyone who was present will not forget last year's blanket finish in the Mackeson Premier. It was a home victory last time with Harry Willison becoming the 1963 Mackeson Champion and the Condor/Mackeson boys taking the team prize.

There has been some reshuffling in the Condor/Mackeson team and this year Willison will be looking for support to Gerald Coles and George Drewell.

Alf Howling, 2nd last year and 3rd in 1962, is here to see if he can do one better; ex-Condor/Mackeson Captain, Alan Jacob, is leading the powerful Ryall/Raxar team and other big names include Falcon Cycle's team of Hitchen, Holmes, Burns and Perks; Dennis Tarr, now with Witcomb Cycles, and veteran Dave Bedwell.

The amateur contingent in the Mackeson Premier is a strong one in this important Olympic year, with Tour of Britain star Tony Culver from Romford, National Champion Bob Addy, Manchester Wheelers' Pete Gordon and 4,000 metres record holder Dave Bonner, who is expected to join the independent ranks shortly.

We are particularly pleased that today's programme will also include a time trial event which is of vital importance, for it is the last official Olympic Games and World Championship Trials before the selection committee meet this evening to pick the teams for Tokyo and France.

The programme begins, as last year, with a 28-lap handicap—an event which proved very popular last time.

All in all, a feast of racing to satisfy the most demanding fan.
