Please report in good time to fix your numbers, which can be exchanged for a free cuppa at the finish

No parking will be allowed on the north (finish) side of the A.299. Please park on the south side, where there is plenty of space.

Riders are requested to take care on the roundabouts, and in particular the far turn, which is a rectangular island with an adverse camber on the far side.

Marker boards will be at 5, 10, 12 $\frac{1}{2}$, 15, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 miles. Times will be taken at 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles.

There will be puncture pits immediately following each roundabout.

Please keep away from the timekeepers. There will be a full result board.

Prizewinners are asked to collect their vouchers from the event secretary at the finish.

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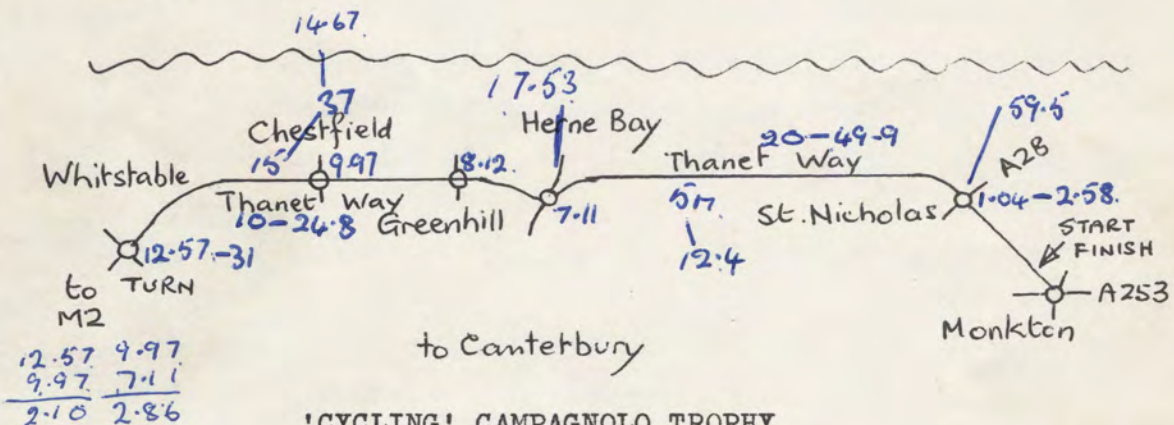
The THANET ROAD CLUB wish all competitors a trouble free ride, a good morning, and a WELCOME to all visitors to Kent.

REMEMBER - HEADS UP - ACCIDENTS DOWN

Q.61 COURSE

Start on A.299 at marked point apx.40 yards north west of Monckton roundabout. Proceed N.W.along A.299 to St.Nicholas roundabout (1.04m) where take second left exit, continuing on A.299 to Herne Bay rounabout (care) (7.11m). Avoid first exit (Canterbury road) and take second exit, continuing on A.299 to Greenhill roundabout (8.12m). Straight on A.299 to Chestfield roundabout (9.97m). Straight on A.299 to Whitstable roundabout ('The Long Reach') (12.57m) where turn and retrace to finish approx.200 yards short of the start.
