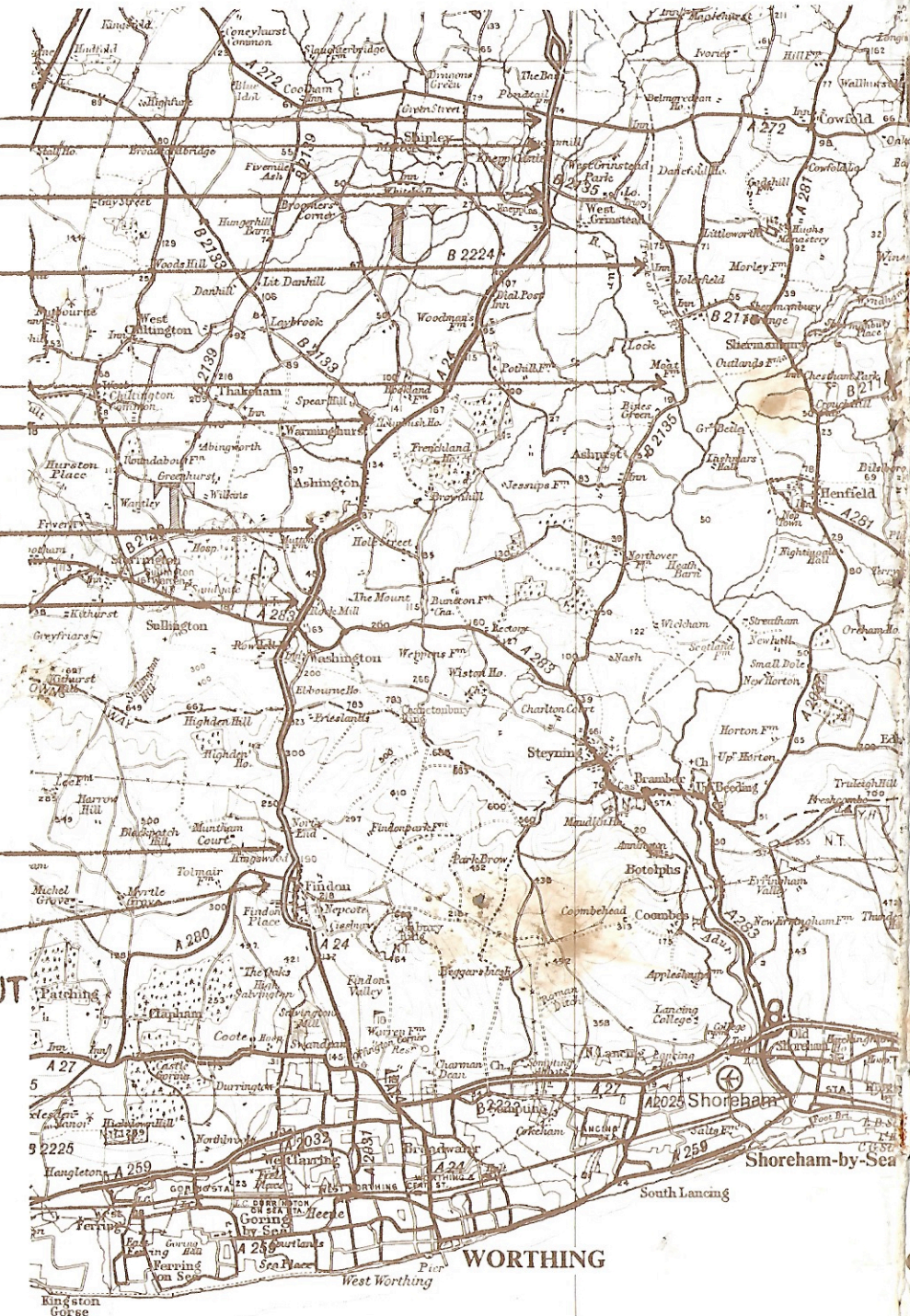

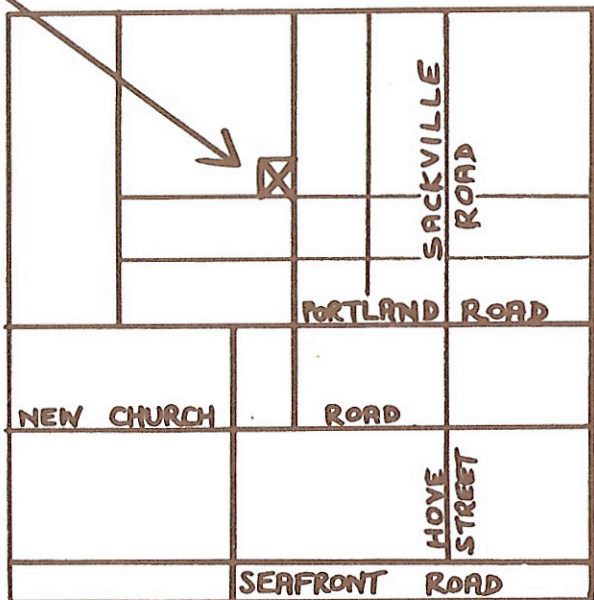

START (O.S. SHEET 182, MAP REFERENCE 165236) ON A.24, 8 YARDS NORTH OF SIGN "A24 WORTHING 15", IN ACCELERATION LANE SOUTH OF THE A24/A272 CROSS ROADS (BUCK BARN)

PROCEED SOUTH ON A24 to B2135 where LEFT (M & P) 0.73 miles
through PARTRIDGE GREEN (not on cover map) to T U R N (M & P) 3.80 miles
(map reference 190181) by drain on east side of road, 55 yards north of where electricity transmission lines cross B2135 (about 0.7 miles south of Partridge Green railway bridge).
RETRACE on B2135 to A24, where LEFT (M & P) 6.87 miles
southwards through DIAL POST and ASHINGTON, and go straight on at WASHINGTON ROUNDABOUT (A24/A283). (M & P) 12.77 miles
Continue on A24 up WASHINGTON HILL and down to FINDON ROUNDABOUT (A24/A280) where E N C I R C L E. (M & P) 15.81 miles
RETRACE on A24 to WASHINGTON ROUNDABOUT (M & P) 18.89 miles
