- 3. No racing between members of a team or between teams or individual riders is permitted. If one team overtakes another the onus shall be upon the overtaken team to avoid such racing by dropping back if necessary
- 4. Every rider in a team time trial shall be separately responsible for keeping a constant look out ahead and obeying all laws, road signs and pdice signals.

That each team must wear jerseys of similar colour & design That its a D.C. reg. that no vehicles shall be parked on the carriage way within sight of the start & finishing points.
