#### Course

Start at Haffenden Quarter (near Smarden) GR 882412 between telephone box and Romden Lane. Proceed east to join A.28 at Bethersden 'Bull'. Turn left and 500 yards later turn left again for Mill Farm. Here left past Runsell Grange towards Pimphurst, where left to pass Pluckley station. Left at Chambers Green to join B.2077, where left again to Maltmans Hill. Fork left (watch for this one) and bearing right at Romden, follow through to finish approximately 60 yards short of the junction at Haffenden.
