


#### Notes for Riders

- 1. The event headquarters are Staplefield Village Hall where changing and toilet facilities are available.
- 2. Body Numbers will be used and will be located at the starting point. Please collect your number at least 5 minutes before your time to start. Numbers to be returned to Event H.Q. in exchange for a free cup of tea. Other refreshments will be on sale at reasonable prices.
- 3. EVIAN vouchers will be presented to prize winners after the event. All other prizes will be paid by cheque with the result sheet. No claims need be submitted.
- 4. Road surfaces for the 25 miles event are reasonably good, apart from the last \( \frac{1}{2} \) mile which is rather rural! Please take care through Handcross and Bolney villages.
- 5. The roads for the 10 mile event are rather narrow and tricky over the last 4 miles. Please take care and watch out for pony riders in the Balcombe area.
- 6. PARKING ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE HANDLED BY JOHN DUTSON and other helpers. Please co-operate to the full.

EARLY ARRIVALS PARK AT VILLAGE HALL (APPROX. 25 cars) APPROX. 6 cars NEAR TELEPHONE BOX. SINGLE LINE PARKING ALONG ROAD BY STAPLEFTELD PLACE (BEWARE SOFT VERGES). LATER ARRIVALS TO PARK IN VICTORY INN CAR PARK. ANY OVERFLOW BY VILLAGE CHURCH. NOTE: NO PARKING ON JOLLY TANNERS CAR PARK.
