Keep your head up - The Law, Regulations and your own safety - all demand it. The event will be under the eagle eye of "Old Bill" so be on your guard.

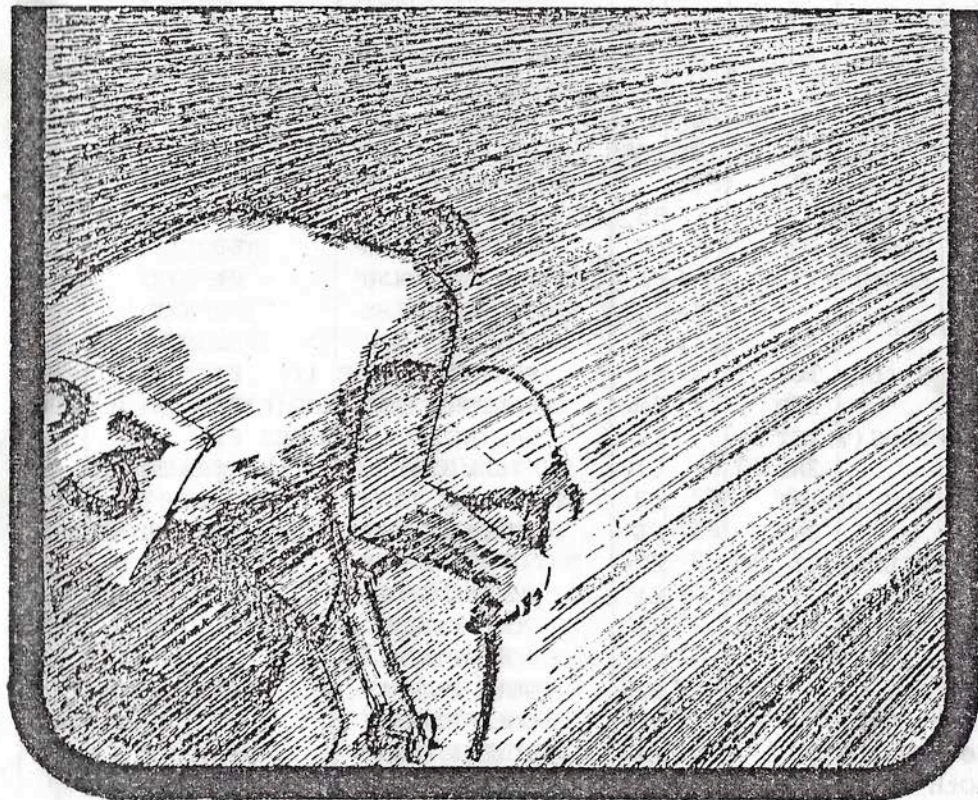

ON THE COURSE

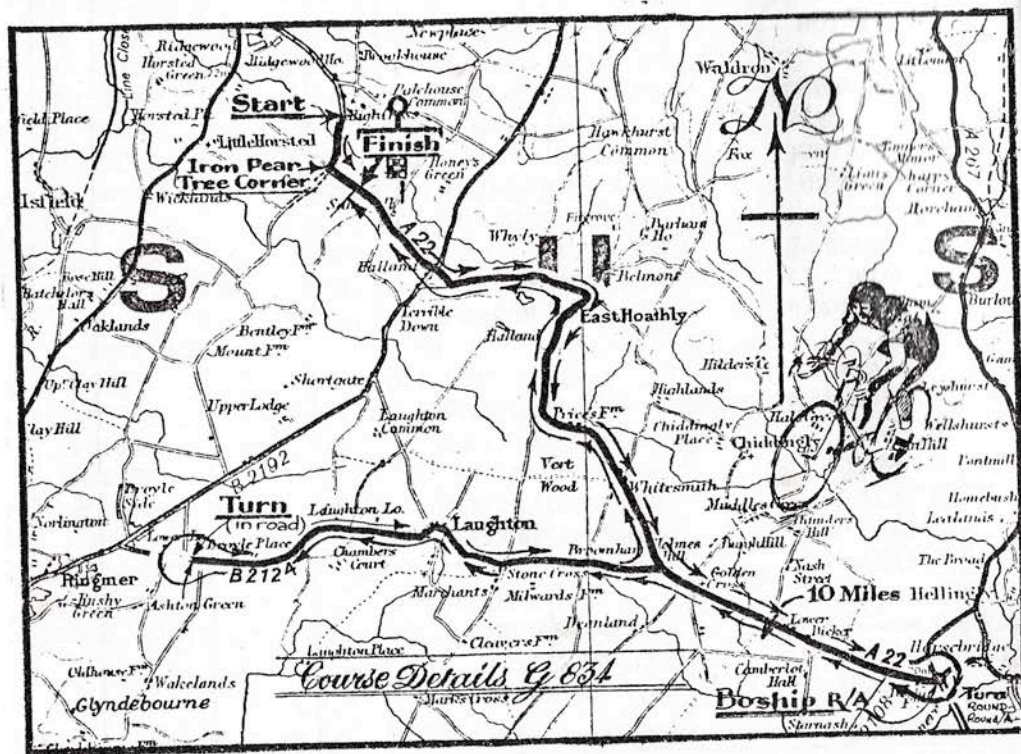
SAG WAGGONS:- Patrol the course, at approx. 15 minute intervals, equipped with roof racks, first aid equipt. etc. Any competitor requiring assistance has only to stand at the roadside facing the sag-waggon and raise his hand above his head. He will then be returned to Iron Pear Tree Corner or to a point of his choice.

MARKERS:- Indicate 5 miles; 10 miles; 1/2 mile to each turn. 1 mile to go and 1/2 mile to go.

Marshalls will be provided with "day-glow" jackets and direction indicators.

FIELD ARRGT

The field arrangement is the responsibility of the event secretary to whom all queries must be referred at IRON PEAR TREE CORNER.



COURSE DETAILS:

EAST SUSSEX G.834
March 1978

- START in Unclassified road - High Cross to Framfield - Approx 2 miles from Uckfield (South) and 1/2 mile south from "Barley Mow" Public House. 2 yds from A.22
- LEFT on to A.22, proceed via Halland and East Hoathly to Boship Roundabout 8.533m
- CIRCLE Roundabout and re-trace along A.22 to junction with B.2124 at Golden Cross 11.065m
- LEFT along B.2124 via Laughton to
- TURN approx 50 yards east of Half Mile Lane, Ringmer and 25 yards short of Pole marked PME - Cobra 1962 (1/2 mile short of junction of B.2124 and B.2192). 15.375m
- RETRACE to A.22 at Golden Cross 19.681m
- LEFT (CARE) along A.22 via East Hoathly and Halland to FINISH at G.P.O. Manhole Covers between Poles No. 13 and 14, just short of M. of T. Bend sign and approx 3/4 mile short of start. 25.000m

Grid References Start TQ 489187
Ringmer Turn TQ 468127
Finish TQ 490178

NOTES

Only the Timekeepers car should be parked at the Finishing point. (The A.22 must be considered a "Clearway"). Cars should be parked in the Starting Lane and the Lane on Left at Iron Pear Tree Corner - avoiding the tended verges outside Cottages and Farms. Riders should not stop at the Finishing point but turn into Lane at Iron Pear Tree Corner before dismounting, (indicated by a red arrow).

This course is G.833 with an amended Turn and Finish.
