COURSE DETAILS: (G.833)

START in unclassified road - High Cross to Framfield - approx 2 miles south of Uckfield and $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Barley Mow Public House on A.22, 2 yards from A.22. LEFT on to A.22 south via Halland and East Hoathly to Boship roundabout (8.533 mls.) CIRCLE roundabout and retrace North on A.22 to Golden Cross (11.065 mls), junction with B.2124, LEFT on to B.2124 via Laughton to TURN (15.375 mls), approximately 50 yards east of Half Mile Lane, Ringmer, and 25 yards short of pole marked PME-COBRA 1962 ($\frac{1}{2}$ mile short of junction of B.2124 and B.2192). RETRACE to Golden Cross (19.681 mls) where LEFT (Care) on to A.22, via East Hoathly and Halland to FINISH at G.P.O. manhole covers between poles 13 and 14 just short of M.O.T. bend sign approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile from start. (This is Course G.833 with amended turn and finish).

Grid Ref: Start TQ 489187 Ringmer turn TQ 468127
Finish TQ 490178

NOTE: Only Timekeepers car to be parked at finishing point.

Vehicles can be parked in lane at start or in lane off Pear Tree corner (by finish), avoiding tended verges outside cottages and farms.

Riders should not stop at the finishing point but turn into lane at Iron Pear Tree Corner before dismounting.
