START	on A.23, south of Crawley 200 yards north of entrance to Broadfields. Proceed northwards to Southgate roundabout (M)	miles
CIRCLE	roundabout and go south on A.23. Climb 'Pease Pottage' to complex at conjunction of A.23 with M.23. Turn left (M) onto bridge over motorway, then right (M) - avoiding fork to Pease Pottage village. Take next left (M) - signposted 'Brighton'. Descend this slip road on to A.23 EXTREME CARE HERE PLEASE - watch for fast moving traffic leaving motorway. Continue southwards on A.23 and on approach to Handcross take left fork A.279 (M)	3.40

Continue straight on along A.23 past Gatwick Airport and again straight on at next two roundabouts (M) to turn at County Oak roundabout (G.R.270/289) 14 miles north of Crawley.

- 1. It is a District Council regulation that no vehicles shall be parked on the highway within sight of the start and finish points.
- 2. For the Shoreham and Back events, ample parking facilities will be available at the event H.Q. BROADFIELD PAVILLION, RATHLIN ROAD, CRAWLEY, which is situated approximately \( \frac{1}{4} \) mile from the start point. See map overleaf. Changing facilities, showers, toilets, teas and a childrens playground will all be available.
- 3. For the '25' and '10' parking facilities will be available in the rear car park of the event H.Q. the POST HOUSE HOTEL, Longbridge roundabout, which is near the start of both events. See map overleaf. Toilets will be available together with teas.
- 4. THE POST HOUSE HOTEL bars and Farmhouse Buttery will be available by courtesy of the management for drinks and light refreshments between events. Please do not abuse this privilege.
- 5. Please keep noise to a minimum before, during and after all events and TAKE YOUR LITTER HOME.
