COURSE (G.834) DETAILS:-

START in unclassified road, High Cross to Framfield approximately 2 miles south of Uckfield and $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Barley Mow P.H. on A.22 road, 2 yards from A.22. LEFT onto A.22 and via Halland and East Hoathly to Boship Roundabout (8.533 miles). CIRCLE roundabout and retrace on A.22 to Golden Cross (11.065 miles) to junction with B.2124. LEFT on to B.2124 via Laughton to turn (15.375 miles) approx. 50 yards east of Half Mile Lane, Ringmer and 25 yards short of Pole marked PME - COBRA 1962 ($1\frac{1}{2}$ mile short of junction of B.2124 and B.2192). Retrace to Golden Cross (19.681 miles) LEFT (CARE) onto A.22 via East Hoathly and Halland to FINISH at G.P.O. Manhole covers between poles 13 and 14 just short of M.O.T. bend sign, approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ mile from start.

- NOTE:
- (1) Only Timekeepers car to be parked at finishing point
 - (2) It is a District Council Regulation that no vehicle shall be parked on carriageway in sight of start or finish.
(Vehicles can be parked in lane at start or finish avoiding tended verges of cottages and farms).
 - (3) Riders should not stop at finish but continue into lane at Iron Pear Tree corner before dismounting.
 - (4) Numbers can be exchanged for a cup of tea at finish.
