

Course Details

Start just east of the Telephone Box at Haffenden Quarter. Proceed to the Bull Inn at Bethersden. Left on A.28 for 400 yards, where left again to bear RIGHT for Mill Farm cross roads. Here left via Hall's Court and Pluckley station to Chambers Green. Left to join B.2077 where left again for Maltman's Hill. FORK LEFT here for Romden Castle, where bear right, to finish 100 yards short of Haffenden Quarter road. 10 Miles
