AWARDS

Scratch & Handicap: 1st £5, 2nd £3, 3rd £2
Fastest Team of three riders (on scratch) £2 per rider
(provided at least 90 entries are received)
Fastest Juvenile £2, Fastest Junior £2, Fastest Lady £2.
Fastest Veteran (on V.T.T.A age standard) £2.
(provided a minimum entry of 5 in each category is received)
(Juveniles may not compete for Junior awards.)

Course Q 10/1

START on the A. 2018 at the clearway sign past Heather Drive. Proceed west to Dartford Heath Roundabout where left to join A.2. Proceed along the A.2 to turn left on the slip road to Bean B.255 to join junction with bridge over the A.2. Turn right then right again ** to retrace to Dartford Heath Roundabout. Turning left off the A.2 on Slip road A.2018. Proceed around the roundabout (extreme caution) to take the third exit to finish at a point 15 yards short of the last drain hole/cover before the M.O.T. Junction sign to Dartford Heath North. Riders should then continue along the A. 2018 and take the first turning on the left before dismounting.

NOTES

GREAT CARE is required at all slip roads, and when passing exit roads, particularly at the Dartford Tunnel exit.

NORMAL TWO-WAY traffic is in operation on the bridge when turning right at Bean. Please take great care and ensure that you are in the correct traffic lane whilst on the bridge.

Crash barriers on the right tend to cause a blind spot when arriving back at Dartford Heath Roundabout. Please use extreme caution when right at this point.

NO CARS are to be parked on the road near the start & finish, as this is a Clearway. There is adequate parking space adjacent to these points on the old A.2.

Flourescent numbers will be used and should be exchanged for a drink at the finish.

PLEASE DO NOT BOTHER the Timekeeper at the finish. Your times will be displayed on the result board.

WARMING UP When warming up, please do not confuse the time-keepers by riding past them in racing strip.

Finally, Good luck to all riders and have a fast and SAFE ride.
