



NOTES TO RIDERS:

1. The event H.Q. is at Staplefield Village Hall where changing and toilet facilities are available. Light refreshments will be available between 10.30 am and 5.00 pm. Competitors will recieve free tea in exchange for their number after events.

2. Body numbers will be used and will be located at the starting point - please collect your number at least 5 minutes before your time of start. Riders competing in the general classification will have the same number for each event.

3. Road surfaces are good for both 10 and 25 miles events - Reasonably light tyres can be used. A bottom gear in the upper 60's should be sufficient.

4. Riders please take extreme care at the 'Red Lion' junction at Handcross - watch out for parked cars. Care is also needed at the mini roundabouts in Cowfold - Give way to traffic from the right: Riders in the 10 miles event watch out for akwardly placed "cats eyes" in the road junction at the Warninglid turn-off (9 miles).

5. All car parking on Staplefield Village Green and in the event H.Q. car park. Absolutely no parking on the pavement near the event H.Q. Note: it is also our club H.Q. and we have to live in peace with our neighbours.

6. There are 2 public houses on the Village Green.
The Victory'and The 'Jolly Tanners' - please don't choke up their car parks.

7. It is a district regulation that no vehicle shall be parked on the carriageway within sight of the start or finishing points.

8. All prize winners will be paid by cheque with the results sheet.
