

Course Q25/2 (Revised)

Start at a marked point on A252, 400 yards west of Dane Court, between poles 6 and 7. Proceed east to Chilham where join A.28 (1.584 mls) to Canterbury where turn at junction with Strangers Lane opposite lamp post No.2086 (5.899 mls). Retrace along A.28 to take left fork at Chilham (10.141 mls) to Ashford to turn at road island at junction with Bybrook Road (17.671 mls) and retrace to finish at vehicle bay outside pumphouse, 250 yards beyond River Stour at Chilham - 25 miles.

Please note revised start, finish and Canterbury turn of this course. The start and finish are now about 2 miles apart so please allow plenty of time to ride to start and fix body numbers which can be exchanged for a cup of tea at the finish. The finish is now 250 yards beyond the old finish, don't stop too soon!

Riders are expected to carry on past the timekeeper before dismounting.

We appologize for the change of course, this is due to 2 sets of traffic lights on the Headcorn Course.

Plastic body numbers will be worn, please allow time to fix these which will be located at the start.

We thank all riders for their support and wish everyone a pleasant and trouble free ride.

This event may be observed so please keep your head up.

R.T.T.C. Regulations

No teams or riders shall take shelter from other vehicles or members of other teams.

The normal formation shall be single file with the minimum amount of echelon to allow a view ahead. In passing other vehicles teams shall always form a single file.

No racing between members of a team or between teams or individual riders is permitted. If one team overtakes another the onus shall be upon the overtaken team to avoid such racing by dropping back if necessary.

Every rider in a team time trail shall be separately responsible for keeping a continuous lookout ahead and obeying all laws, road signs and police signals.

All riders of each team shall be attired in jerseys of similar colour and design.
