E.73 30- MILE COURSE

START at second clearway sign, right hand side of slip road leading from the fly-over at the London end of Witham by-pass from the B.1389. Proceed to join the A.12 and shortly bear left (M) on slip road towards Hatfield Peverel, and again shortly turn right (M.& C) over bridge across A.12 to rejoin Eastbound carriageway. Follow A.12 to A.604 junction where bear left onto slip road to A.604 (M & C) (14 miles). At roundabout turn right (M) and continue to roundabout at old A.12 where turn right (M) to Marks Tey where encircle roundabout (M & C) (16.8 miles). Retrace to roundabout (M) where left and left at next roundabout to join A.12 by means of slip road (M). Follow A.12 towards London to the slip road to the B.1389 Witham road and across A.12 left into Freebourne Road (M) to FINISH at L.P.40.

CAR PARKING.

Please park at the FINISH, where there is ample space. There is no parking space near the Start.

Allow about fifteen minutes to ride to the START and fix your number.
