Course Details

Event H.Q. Bell's Yew Green Village Hall. Frant/Wadhurst circuit - line up for start in lane opposite Bell's Yew Green post office. Proceed across crossroads into Station Road (unclass) to Frant, keep LEFT (M) through green LEFT (M,C) onto A.267 to Sleeches Cross LEFT (M) onto B2099 past Wadhurst station to Dungates LEFT (M,C) onto B.2100 through Sparrow's Green and Cousley Wood to Lamberhurst Common LEFT (M) onto B.2169 to Hook Green and Bell's Yew Green LEFT (M,C) onto Station Road to complete 1 circuit. (1 lap = 13.062 miles). Complete 2 laps then on last circuit continue on B.2169 through Bell's Yew Green for 1.25 miles to finish by Tunbridge Wells sign (40.436 miles).
