## G 962

Sponsored by the Sussex Mutual Building Society

**START** (Map Ref. 939073) at Fontwell at the junction of the A27 and Level Mare Lane proceed westwards on the A27 to **WESTHAMPNETT ROUNDABOUT** where **TURN** and retrace through start to Arundel By-Pass to Offington Corner where left on the A24 to **FINDON ROUNDABOUT** where **TURN** and retrace to Offington Corner where right on the A27 to junction with A280 at Patching where left to Angmering Roundabout where left on A259 via new roundabout at Roundstone to Goring Roundabout where straight on to **TURN AT DURRINGTON ROUNDABOUT** and retrace via Goring, Roundstone and Angmering Roundabouts where right on the A280 to Patching where left on the A27 to the Arundel By-Pass continue on to **WESTHAMPNETT ROUNDABOUT** where take the second exit into Chichester taking the one-way system to join the A259 where left to the Four Chestnuts public house where fork right to Bognor Bridge Roundabout where take the second exit continue on the A259 to **TURN AT THE ROUNDABOUT IN BOGNOR** retrace on the A259 to Bognor Bridge Roundabout where immediately turn left into Vinnetrow Road to the Walnut Tree public house at Runcton where left on the B2166 to Lagness where continue on to the **TURN** at TP2 500 yards south of Sefter School retrace to Walnut Tree public house at Runcton where right into Vinnetrow Road to Bognor Bridge Roundabout where left on the A27 via Roundabouts at Whyke, Selsey Road, Bosham, Emsworth, and Warblington to **TURN AT LANGSTONE ROUNDABOUT** where retrace on the A27 to **BOGNOR BRIDGE ROUNDABOUT** where left into Chichester on the A259 following the one-way system where right at Eastgate Square to **WESTHAMPNETT ROUNDABOUT** where take the second exit to join the A27 where continue eastwards past the start at Fontwell where turn left into Britzens Lane to the **FINISH** opposite TP11 approx. 800 yards north of the A27 (Map Ref. 941078).

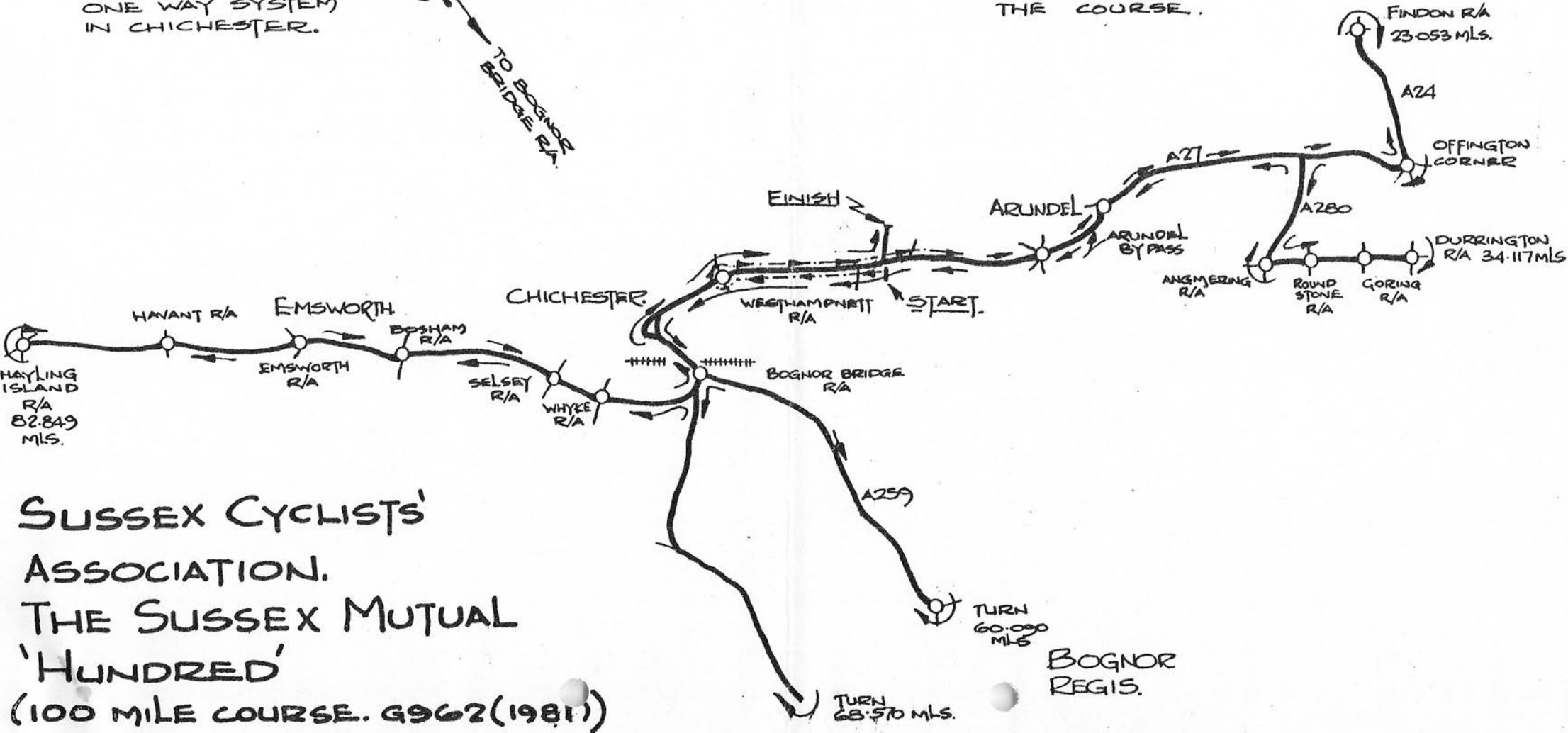
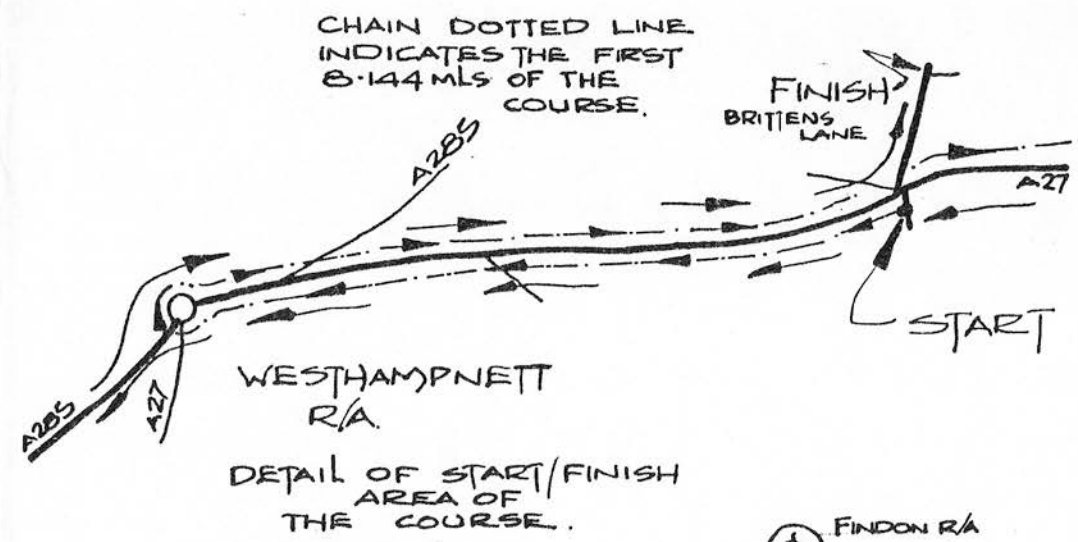
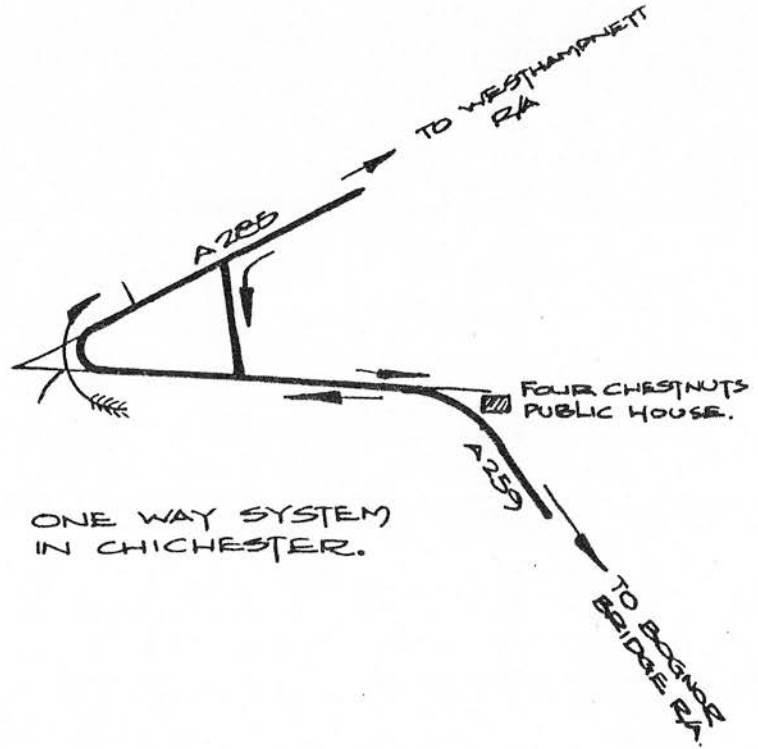
