Course Details

Line up for start outside event headquarters, Frant Village Hall, Frant Green, East Sussex. Proceed to A267 and turn LEFT (M,C) to Sleeches Cross where LEFT (M) onto B2099. Proceed past Wadhurst Station to Durgates where LEFT (M) (C) onto B2100. Continue thru' Sparrows Green and Cousley Wood to Lamberhurst Common where turn LEFT (M) onto B2169 and proceed via Hook Green to Bell's Yew Green. Turn LEFT (M) (C) along unclassified Station Road to complete circuit at Frant Green. 1 lap = 13.062 miles.

Race distance is just short of four laps (52.223 miles)

Prime points at FINISHING point, situated outside iron gates to Ely Grange on the climb up Station Road just short of completion of circuit at Frant Green.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

It is a Sussex Division Ruling that NO vehicles, officials or otherwise, to be parked within 200 yards of the finish.

COMPETITORS' NOTES

- 1. Competitors are not permitted to have following vehicles of any sort. There are plenty of "static" spectating points. Non-observance of this point will subject a rider to disqualification.
- 2. Competitors will be disqualified for foolish or reckless behaviour and must completely observe the Highway Code. All instructions to be obeyed.
- 3. First Aid facilities will be available, kindly provided by members of St. John Ambulance Brigade (Wadhurst division).
- 4. Remember your crash hat and licence to avoid disappointment.
- 5. Machine examination commences 1 hour before starting time. You must be cleared for signing on no later than 20 minutes before the race start.
- 6. Prizes will be presented after result is declared official. Licences will not be returned until after race.
- 7. Refreshments available during and after event at headquarters. Please help keep premises clean & tidy.
- 8. No vehicles on the circuit near start or finish.
