Course Details 0.25/1

Start opposite T.P. 18 approximately 20 yards south of Headcorn Railway Bridge on A.274. Proceed south through Biddenden to London Beach (6m 406 yds). Left through lane and left at end onto A.28. Proceed through High Halden and Bethersden to turn at site of A.A. box (now removed) at Gablehook (12m 394 yds). Retrace to London Beach to turn at entrance to Beechwood Farm at St. Michaels (Tenterden) (18m 1159 yds). Retrace to London Beach and keep left on A.282 to Biddenden, straight on A.274 through Biddenden to finish at T.P. at north west corner of Bletchenden cross roads. (25 miles).
