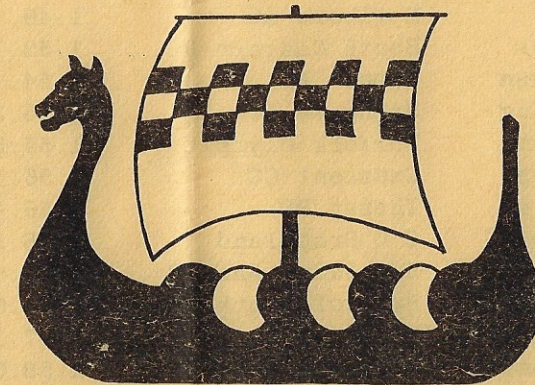

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

The Event Secretary (who is now taking bribes for good positions in next years field) thanks all those who contributed to this event especially the man with the smoke machine in Chelmsford. As you all know, the resulting fog caused a 40 minute interruption to the event and resulting discomfort to the officials and 32 marshalls all of whom accepted this additional chore without complaint.

It is interesting to compare the resulting "Two Events" of the first 69 riders (ie Nos 4 to 73) 59 started and 55 finished of those 32 were outside their current best by an average of 3m.25s and 19 recorded personal bests by an average of 3m.57s. This is an overall average deficit on current best of 38 seconds. Of the last 37 riders (nos 74 to 110) 31 started and 23 finished. Only two riders* were outside their current best and by only 32 secs 20 riders recorded personal bests by an average of 6m.19. This is an overall average improvement on current best of 5m48.

As the weather conditions were near enough equal throughout the event the traffic would appear to be worth 6½ minutes.
