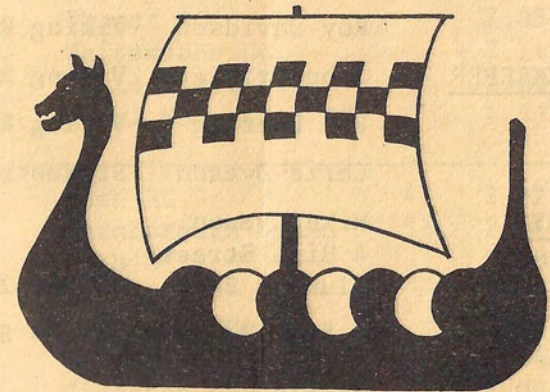

Details of Course

Start in B1389 (old A12) just north east of Witham, AT L.P. No. 10 adjacent to Wimpeys Office on north side of road. This is  $\frac{1}{8}$  mile west of junction with Freebourne Road and almost opposite the 38 milestone from London. Proceed to flyover north east of Witham (M) where right over the A12 and left into slip road, to join the London-bound carriageway of A12. Proceed via Hatfield Peveral and Boreham Bypass to Springfield where left (M) into slip road to roundabout (8.81miles). Take first exit into B1137 (M&C) via Boreham Village to Crix Lodge (12.19 miles) Turn right and right again (care) (M) into Damasas Lane, to rejoin B1137 where left (M) and retrace to springfield roundabout (16.08 miles). Take third exit into A1113 passing under A12 and in a few yards turn right (care) through intersection opposite Pump Lane (M&C) to join slip road and A12. Proceed to Stanway /A604 junction, turn right (M) to roundabout junction with B1408 (M&C). Turn right again via Copford to turn at first roundabout at Marks Tey (M&C). Retrace to A12 at Stanway/A604 junction, where left (M) down slip road to rejoin A12. (39.75 Miles) Proceed to end of the Witham bypass, where left up slip road (M) (48.96 miles), across the A12 into the B1389 and turn left into Freebourne Road (M&C) to finish inline with L.P. No33 (on central reservation) just past entrance to Wheaton Road, at far end of Industrial Estate.

COMPETITORS NOTES

The course requires a great number of marshalls and officials. It works out at one for every two riders. They'll turn out whatever the weather. Make their effort worth while by starting this event even if your personal ambition seems unobtainable.

The bends at Crix Lodge at about the quarter distance are sharp and the road surfaces bad. Riders who intend taking risks should also take first-aid kits. This also applies to the turn into the industrial estate 3/4 mile before the finish.

We have requested the Council to open up the toilets in the centre of Witham earlier than usual. No reply has, as yet, been received but if in need you can travel to the south end of the Witham by-pass where all night toilets are situated (by the 25 start)

NO PARKING at the start. Use Freebourne Road close to the finish. Do not park on factory premises.

Collect numbers at start and exchange them for tea at Spud Potter's travelling emporium at the finish. To savour the full delights of this service you should ride 50 miles between the two points concerned.

No Drinks or Food will be handed up by the organisers.

In the interest of aerodynamics keep your head up. The front of your head is suitably pointed.
