COURSE DETAILS G213

Start GRO71/582 between 5th and 6th drains 150 yards NE of bus stop in lay-by off London bound carriageway of A3 at Wisley Gardens. Proceed NE along A3 for 5 miles to FORK LEFT (M) at A214 intersection, GR141/623 down slip road to TURN around Oxshott Roundabout (Check with 3 M's) then take 4th exit to climb 5.4m up to Guildford bound carriageway GRO79/590 and along A3 to FINISH approx 1/4 mile after Downside Lane at a point 85 yards after "Services 1M" sign. 10.0m

On finishing riders must continue along A3 and turn into Effingham Lane before dismounting.

It is a District Regulation that no vehicles shall be parked on the carriageway within sight of the starting or finishing points. This applies also on the verges and anywhere in the village of Ockham. Headquarters and car park are now in the second space along Effingham Lane. The Start is reached by proceeding SW along the A3 and then turning around the Ockham Roundabout and retracing along the London bound carriageway of the A3. The distance is approx 2 miles.

Riders and others must NOT under any circumstances cross the central reservation or the carriageways of the A3.
