

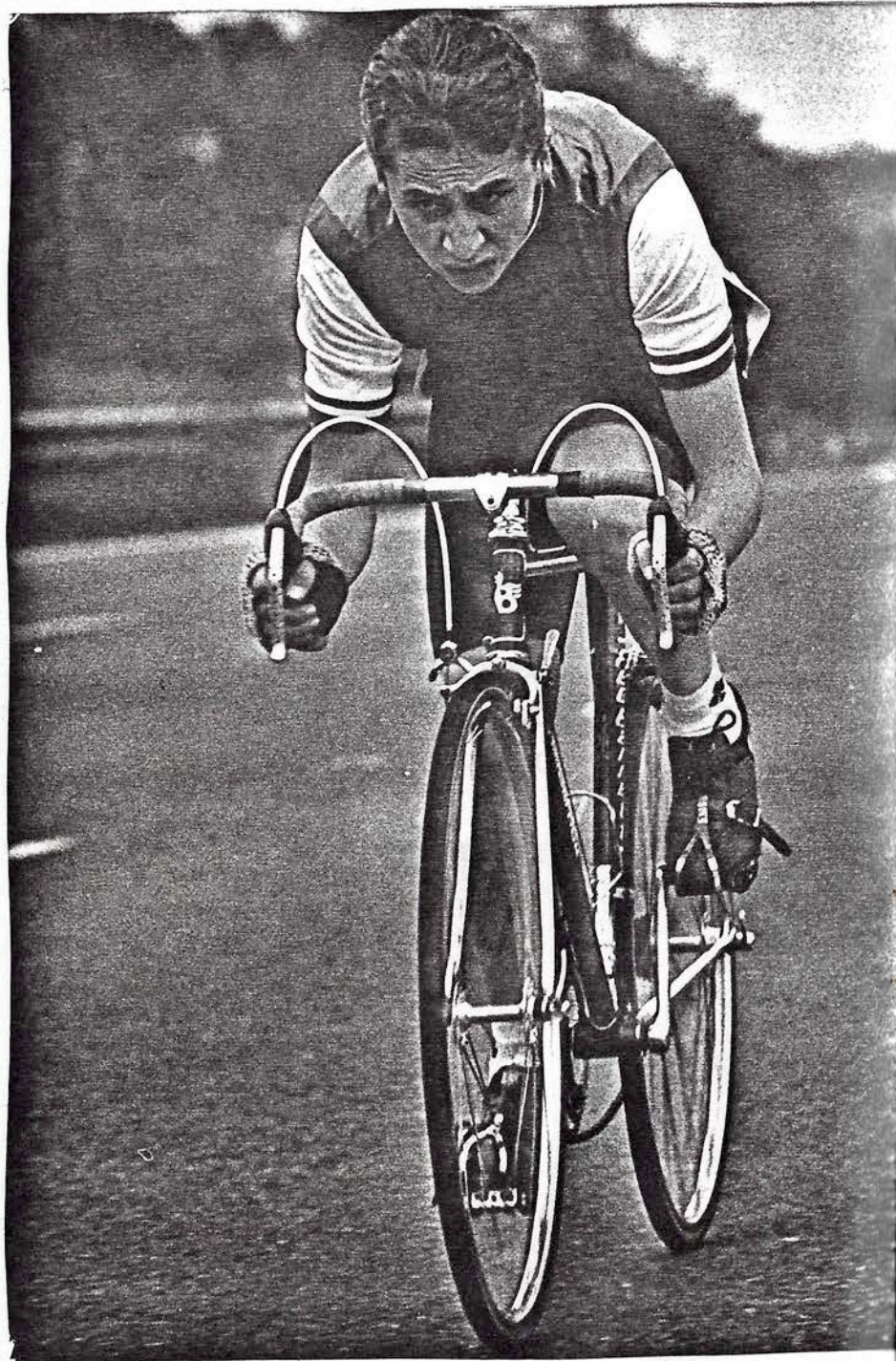

Times that qualify schoolboy riders for standard medals, and the rules that govern the competition, are as follows:

	<u>bronze</u>	<u>silver</u>	<u>gold</u>
under 13	33.30	32.30	30.30
under 14	31.00	29.00	27.00
under 15	29.00	27.30	26.00
under 16	28.00	26.30	25.00

The standards are for 10 miles. Times recorded on any course to count.

There is a fee of 50p - payable to the Secretary.

Times to count from receipt of fee.

One fee - one medal. All three standards can be acquired, but it costs 50p for each grade.

If you haven't achieved a standard before your birthday, the 50p will be carried on, but you will have to try for the faster set of times.

The medals awarded will be coloured bronze, silver or gilt metal with a 'cyclist' centre.
