NIGHTFARER is the quality name in bicycle lighting. Our sets give a splendid 4 watts halogen front light, 1.2 watts rear light with unrivalled reliability. The battery, which weighs 3lbs uses two CYCLON cells that power the lights for a maximum of 3 hours. The cells may be expected to last about 1000 working hours and when worn out you can replace them yourself at reasonable cost (currently £4 each).

You have to recharge for four times the duration of your burn. However you can recharge overnight even if your discharge has only been shallow. It takes only seconds to attach the charger lead when you return home. In many

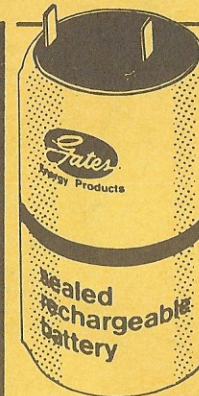
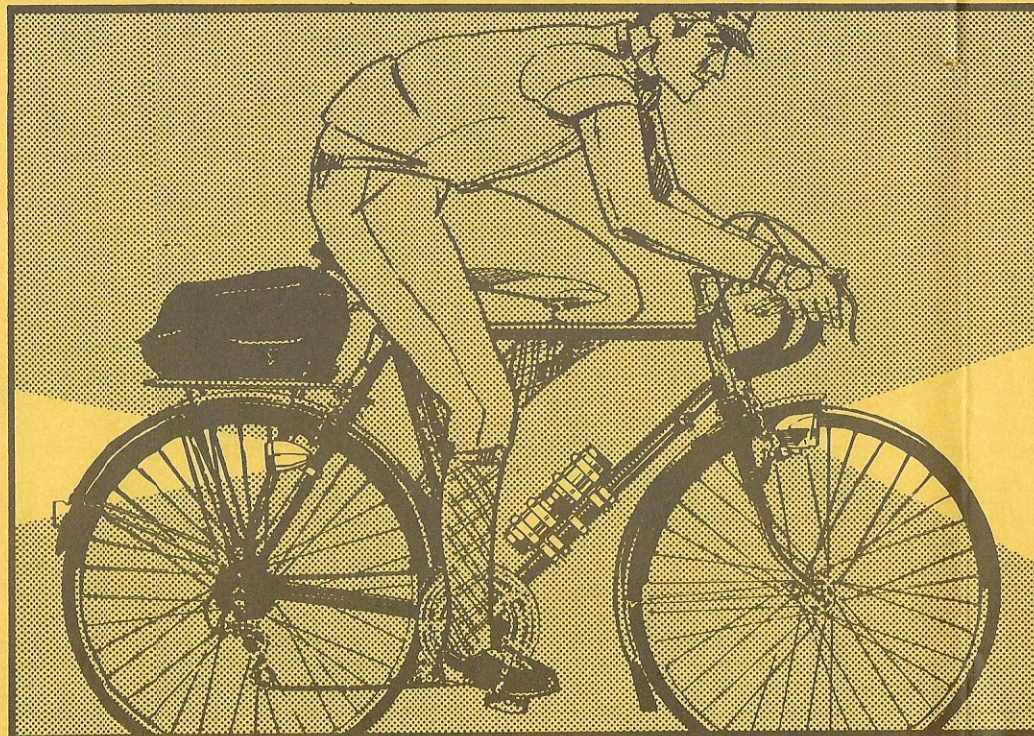
cases families find one charger adequate for several lighting sets.

Each set comes complete with battery, front and rear lamps, spare bulbs, spare fuses and clips for securing the battery cable. Simple fitting and operating instructions are included. NIGHTFARER is a product that is backed by spare parts too . . .

The set fits bicycles of all sizes but the down tube must have the standard 1 1/8" dia. The set is not suitable for habitual removal and replacement and is best left permanently fitted.

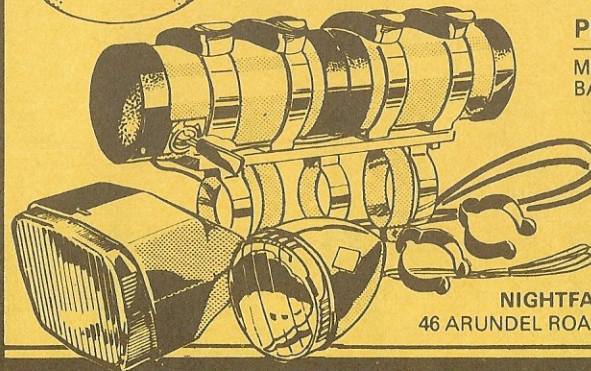
