MASTINGS and St Leonards Cycling Club ran two races for members last weekend.

The 10-mile team race at Pevensby on Saturday afternoon was run in windy conditions, with four teams competing. Winners were Robert Siev and veteran Vic Butler who recorded 25min 20sec, followed by last-minute pairing Mark Markowski and Steve Geran in 26min 15sec, and Alan Brooks helping novice Danny Clehane to 26min 48sec.

Nigel Davies rode alone to record 28min 30sec and all-veteran team Tony Jovens and Bruce Mitchell returned 29min 4sec.

The rain, which had held off on Saturday, was not so kind on Sunday when four riders splashed over the 25-mile course from Shirley to Horshambridge.

Alan Brooks had a clear win, riding strongly to record the 7min 7sec in shot and snow. Wayne Spears was second in the 13min 14sec, showing promise of fast rides later in the season. Vic Butler finished in the 13min 53sec and Danny Clehane in the 22min 32sec.
