VIC Butler and Robert Sier had a second team time trial success in Sunday's Hastings and St Leonards Cycling Club 15-mile race at Pevensey to follow their 10-mile win in March.

On a warm, still morning they returned a time of 35min 48sec, well clear of runners-up Richard Bateman and his father, in 39min 18sec.

Tony Jevons and Bruce Mitchell combined well to record 40min 36sec.

Other club members preferred solo rides, and Mark Markowski's winning 36min 06sec, confirmed the good form he is currently enjoying.

Dave Blackman clocked 38min 44sec, Wayne Spears 39min 59sec and Jeff Smith 41min 32sec. A number of Eastbourne Rovers riders also completed, their best being D Picked, with 38min 0sec.

Vic Butler and Robert Sier rode in the Crawley Wheelers hilly 39½-mile event on Good Friday, finishing with 1hr 54min 19sec and 1hr 46min 49sec respectively.
