### NOTES

HELPERS - Do not use or congregate by the car parks of "The Chequers" at Ugley, or the "King William IV" at Leaden Roding. Noise and disturbance at a previous event has caused a strained relationship with both Landlords.

Under no circumstances may helpers/spectators assemble at Blocks Corner. Please go towards Hatfield Broad Oak or towards White Roding.

CUT OUTS As far as possible the Start Sheet will indicate any cut out you will be required to make. The officers in charge of the cut-outs Mr May at Leaden Roding & Mr Osborne at Sawston, have full discretion to include or exclude a particular rider from a specific detour. The Leaden Roding/Dunmow detour will be closed at 1 hr. after the first rider on road completer detour & the Sawston/Royston detour closed  $\frac{1}{2}$ hr after first rider completes.

Leaden Roding(115.96)-Dunmow & back deduct 11.37 miles.  
Sawston RAB(173.04)-Royston & back deduct 19.42 miles.  
Riders who are turned at Orsett(60.59) - deduct 10.81 miles

## NOTES TO COMPETITORS

**Numbers** - Riders will carry frame number and body number. Please report five minutes earlier than starting time to collect these and fit. The frame numbers are necessary for easy recognition on finishing circuit.

**Marshals** - There should be over 70 marshals around the course; whilst every care has been taken to ensure riders have no difficulty, the onus of keeping to the course rests with each rider.

**Vehicles** - R.T.T.C. Regulation 53 allows for assisting vehicles to be used provided these are registered with the event organiser prior to the start. Send 16p stamped addressed envelope for a form.

**Litter** - Please retain litter and drop it at the next feeding station.

**Result Board** - Estimated Mileages will be displayed on the board at H.Q. Do not consult the main timekeeper.

**Refreshments** - From 2p.m. at the H.Q. Hot and Cold drinks will be available together with sandwiches, cakes, etc. Riders can exchange their body number for a drink. Please hand in frame numbers at the same time.

**Parking** - The area each side and in front of the Event H.Q. must be kept clear of vehicles.

**Last Man** - If you are sure you are last on the road the Marshals would appreciate your telling them so.

**Lights** - None are necessary.

### NOTES FOR RIDERS & TIMEKEEPERS

Hopefully, all circuit timekeepers points will be covered, if a Timekeeper is not available carry on to next mile point. The 12 Mile point (White Roding) 14 Mile Point (Leaden Roding) 15 mile point (Aythorpe Roding) are sited badly and may not be covered.

**ALL MILE POINTS ARE PAINTED IN LIME GREEN. AS ARE ANY DIRECTIONAL ARROWS ON CIRCUIT.**

**COURSE** Because of roadworks Riders must take especial care at the roundabout (60m) at Orsett, where riders turn right from A128 to join the A13.
