NIGHTFARER is the quality name in bicycle lighting. Our sets give a splendid 4 watts Krypton front light, 1.2 watts rear light with unrivalled reliability. The battery, which weighs 3lbs uses two CYCLON cells that power the lights for a maximum of 3 hours. The cells may be expected to last about 1000 working hours and when worn out you can replace them yourself at reasonable cost (currently £4 each).

You have to recharge for four times the duration of your burn. However you can recharge overnight even if your discharge has only been shallow. It takes only seconds to attach the charger lead when you return home. In many

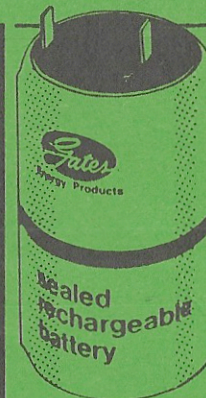
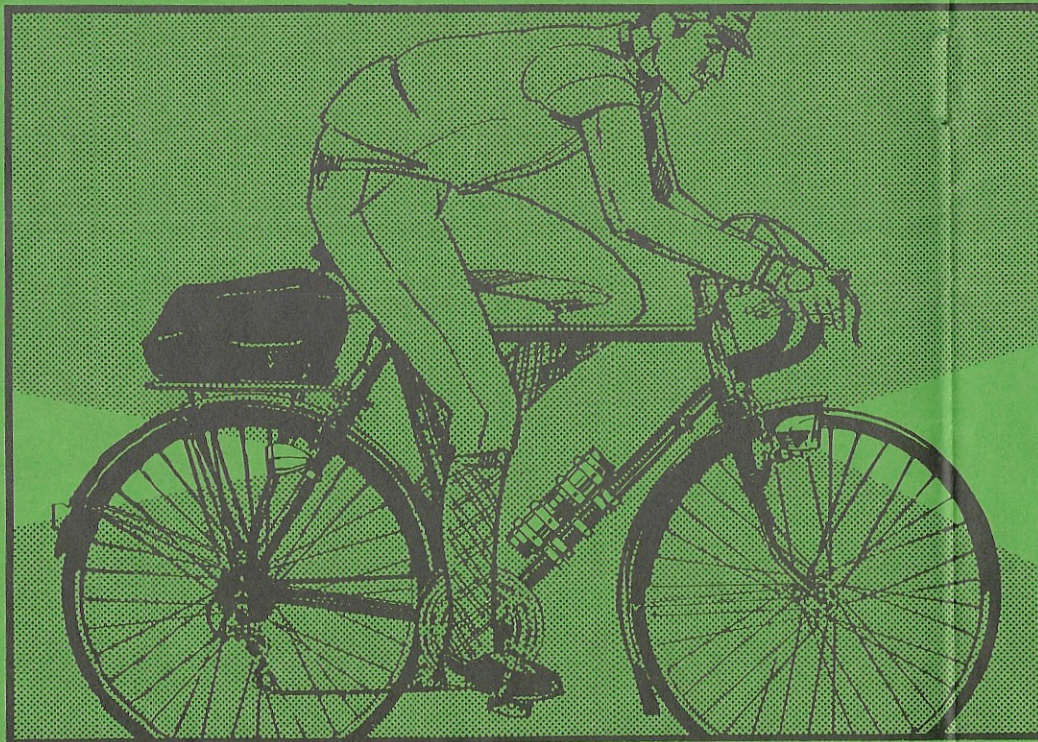
cases families find one charger adequate for several lighting sets.

Each set comes complete with battery, front and rear lamps, spare bulbs, spare fuses and clips for securing the battery cable. Simple fitting and operating instructions are included. NIGHTFARER is a product that is backed by spare parts too . . .

The set fits bicycles of all sizes but the down tube must have the standard 1 1/8" dia. The set is not suitable for habitual removal and replacement and is best left permanently fitted.

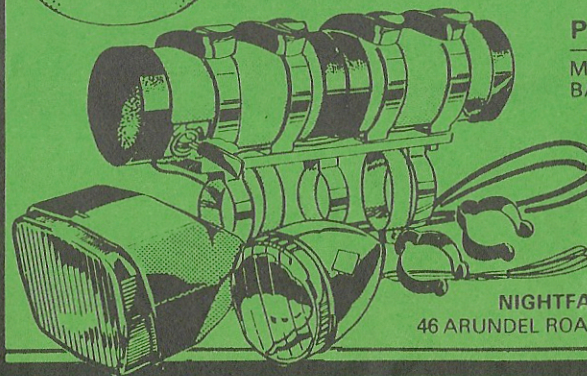

**COURSE - G.938. (Course & Event Record - 53 1 - Tony Deacon 1984).**

START (O.S. Sheet 182, MR 073507) on A27 near top of Hammerpot Hill, 4 miles East of Arundel at 7th kerbstone North of 'Give Way' sign in Dappers Lane, Angmering (unclassified road), 5 yards from A27.  
 PROCEED Westwards on A27 to Arundel By-Pass, where take first exit at roundabout, continuing on A27 along the ARUNDEL-BY-PASS to next roundabout, where take 2nd exit, still on A27 to WESTHAMPNETT roundabout at Eastern end of CHICHESTER-BY-PASS. Encircle roundabout, (MR 877059) and retrace Eastwards on A27, following the single carriageway A27 to the right at its junction with the A285 to the ARUNDEL-BY-PASS, where go right at the 1st roundabout (3rd exit on left), and right at 2nd roundabout (2nd exit on left), still on A27 to FINISH opposite telegraph pole DP8 at entrance to New Place Farm, 1/2 mile West of start.

PLEASE PARK in Lay-By West of FINISH, or Lay-By on South side of road and West of the Finish, or on verges. It is a London South DC Regulation that no cars be parked on the carriageway within sight of START or FINISH. Also, the lane East of the finish is an access road to the pub at the foot of the hill, so do not misuse this land.

WARMING-up. No right turns from the start. You must go left and down the hill on the A27.

DISTANCE BOARDS will be accurately located at 5, 10, 12 1/2, 15, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 miles.

FINISH will be located by a chequered board and a board marked "FINISH".

MARSHALS will mostly wear red fluorescent slip-overs.

FLUORESCENT PIN-ON BODY NUMBERS will be found at the start.

ROUNDAOUBTS If wet, please exercise care.

TOILET TENTS will be found near the finish.

MIST If visibility is poor, the start will be delayed as long as necessary.

TIMEKEEPERS: MIKE KILBY (Lewes Wanderers) at the start.  
 JOHN PILBEAM (Bognor Regis CC) at 12 1/2 miles.  
 BRIAN COX (Hants RC) at the finish,  
 with BETTY COX (Hants RC) recording.
