

COMPETITORS NOTES

The North East District welcomes all competitors to this our first R.T.T.C. National Championship promotion. May we wish you all a trouble-free ride and an enjoyable day in the North East.

Routes to Stanhope

1. From the Al South

Leave Al at Scotch Corner. Turn left along A66 and follow signs to Barnard Castle. Leave Barnard Castle on A688 (Staindrop/Bishop Auckland Road) and fork left approx. Amile from town centre onto B6278 via Eggleston to Stanhope. At T-junction with A689 turn right. Crawleyside hill is the first turn left.

2. From the M6 South

Leave M6 at junction 38 (Tebay). Turn right along A685 to Brough. Follow signs for Middleton-in-Teesdale, B6276. Leave Middleton-in-Teesdale with signs for Stanhope on unclassified road to T-junction with B6278. Turn left to Stanhope and follow the instructions above on reaching Stanhope.

3. From the M6 North

Follow route to Alston where take A689 to Stanhope. Alternatively, follow route to Brough and then follow instructions in para. 2 above.

Race H.Q.

STANHOPE BARRINGTON C.E. SCHOOL Emma Street, Stanhope

Course Details

START on B6278 north of Stanhope in line with drainage grid 30yards beyond telegraph pole and approx. 70yards beyond the last house on the west side of the road after the 30m.p.h. speed limit derestriction sign. Proceed north up the hill through Crawleyside village to FINISH at the brow of the hill approx. 10yards past grid on right hand side of the road and approx. 100yards before the road junction to Blanchland.

Course Profile


The first 600yards is a l-in-8 gradient. The road then steepens through Crawleyside village to l-in-6 to the amile point on the course. After crossing the cattle-grid the road reaches open moorland and the gradient averages l-in-lo (slightly stepped climb) to the 1.85mile point. There is a short descent followed by a shallower sweeping climb to the finish.

Gears are strongly recommended. Depending on the wind strength and direction on the day, and of course your own strength, the top section of the hill could be a big ring job.

COMPETITORS INSTRUCTIONS

- Cars are not to be taken into Emma Street to the Race H.O. Cars may be parked on the A689 - South side only.
- The Race H.Q. is situated at the bottom of the hill in Stanhope close to the START. Changing, washing and toilet facilities are available in the H.Q. Also refreshements will be available.
- Numbers will be available at the Race H.Q. One body and two arm numbers are to be worn by all competitors. Allow 5 minutes to ride from the H.Q. to the Start.
- Numbers should be handed in to the Number Stewards adjacent to the Result Board at the finish.
- There will be parking restrictions in Stanhope, and also up the Championship Hill. Note that the road is not closed for the event and light traffic may be encountered during the event in both directions. There is to be no parking on the B6278 from the T-junction (A689) at the bottom of the hill to the fork junction just beyond the finish at the top.
- Limited space is available on the Common at the top of the hill for Competitors and officials. To gain access you will need to show your Cark Park Pass. If you are travelling with another competitor do not give your Car Park Pass to somebody you know who is spectating - it may be you who does not get onto the car park.
- Spectator car parking will be along the west side only of the unclassified road to Blanchland (left fork immediately after the finish). Make sure that you and your helpers have adequate clothing if you intend to spectate at the event. The top of the hill is exposed open moorland - you may need plenty of warm clothing and waterproofs should the weather be inclement.
- PRESENTATION OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP AWARD WINNERS will be at the Result Board adjacent to the finish shortly after the last competitor has finished.
- Please respect the trust placed in us by the owners and graziers in granting permission for us to use the land at the Finish. This land is open grazing land. PLEASE LEAVE NO LITTER, PLASTIC BAGS, GLASS BOTTLES, ETC. which could HARM OR INJURE THE ANIMALS.
