START in lay-by at Milton Hide, Arlington Road West, one mile west of Hailsham. Go east to A.22, where LEFT to BOSHIP ROUNDABOUT (2.684 miles). Take first exit and 7.75 continue on A.22 to GOLDEN CROSS (5.260 miles). LEFT on B.2124 via Laughton and 14 06 Ringmer to TURN at "Give Way" sign 150 yards short of junction with A.26 at EARWIG CORNER, LEWES (12.631 miles).

RETRACE through Ringmer and Laughton to GOLDEN CROSS (20.002 miles). LEFT on A.22 54via Fast Hoathly to junction of A.22 and A.26 at UNION POINT, UCKFIELD (27.286 miles). 1-13-30 TURN round small traffic island.

RETRACE via East Hoethly on A.22 to Boship Koundabout. Take third exit to continue on A.22 to junction with A.27 at POLEGATE (40.797 miles). LEFT on A.27, past Polegate 1-30 railway station, to junction with B.2104 at Stone Cross. LEFT on B.2104 to just short of junction with A.259 at HAILSHAM, where TURN at last electricity pole opposite 2-07 bus stop (47.138 miles).

RETRACE to STONE CROSS (50.966 miles) and LEFT on A.27 via Pevensey (OBEY TRAFFIC 2-17 LIGHTS) and Marsh Road to Tuth at Little Common Roundabout, BEXHILL (58.396 miles). 2-37

RETRACE on A.27 via Pevensey and Stone Cross to junction with A.22 at Polegate. LEFT on A.22 to junction with A.27 just beyond railway bridge (68.825 miles). RIGHT on 3.05 A.27 via Selmeston to junction with A.25 (formerly B.2109) at BEDDINGHAM (77.787 miles). LEFT on A.26 via South Heighton (AVOIDING LEFT FORK TO DENTON) to TURN at NEWHAVEN - 3-30 at the drain between Haven Foundry and Brighton Scaffolding, opposite lamp-post No.6, about 500 yards short of A.259 flyover (82.722 miles).

RETRACE to junction with A.27 at BEDDINGHAM (87.657 miles) where RIGHT WITH GREAT CARE on to A.27 via Selmeston to junction with A.22 at POLEGAIE (96.501 miles). LEFT on A.22 to Arlington Road West, where LEFT to FINISH by the start at MILTON HIDE. 4-20

EVENT HUADOUARTERS: The village hall at Upper Dicker, one mile from the start, will be available from about 5.30a.m. There are showers in the hall, but riders should bring their own soap (and towels!). The result board will be there, as will the usual free cup of tea in exchange for a number.
