START (Map ref. 121132) At large illuminated sign on A263 at Washington proceed to roundabout where right on the A24 via Ashington and Dial Post to traffic lights at West Grinstead cross roads (which must be obeyed) continue to <u>SOUTHWATER ROUNDABOUT</u> at the southern end of the by-pass where encircle and retrace on the A24 to the traffic lights at West Grinstead (which must be obeyed) where left on A272 to Cowfold where right on mini roundabout where right again at second mini roundabout on A281 to Henfield where left at mini roundabout at end of village via Woodmancote to <u>POYNINGS ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle via Henfield to Cowfold where left on A272 to West Grinstead cross roads where left though filter at traffic lights on to A24 proceed south to <u>WASHINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where left on A283 via roundabouts at Bramber and Beeding to <u>SHOREHAM ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace to Washington roundabout where left on A24 to <u>OFFINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where right on A27 to Patching where left on A280 to Angmering roundabout where left on A259 via roundabouts at Roundstone Goring and West Durrington to <u>EAST DURRINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace to Angmering roundabout where continue straight on A259 over railway bridge where right at the Windmill roundabout to <u>TURN</u> at the roundabout at Littlehampton Cemetary retrace to Anmering roundabout where left on A280 to junction with A27 at Patching where left via Arundel by-pass to <u>WESTHAMPNETT ROUNDABOUT</u> where left on the Chichester by-pass via traffic lights (which must be obeyed) to Bognor Bridge roundabout where left on A259 to <u>TURN</u> at large roundabout in in Bognor retrace to Bognor Bridge roundabout where left on A27 proceed westwards via roundabouts at Whyke, Selsey Road, Bosham and Emsworth to <u>WARBLINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace on A27 via traffic lights on the Chichester by-pass (which must be obeyed) to <u>WESTHAMPNETT ROUNDABOUT</u> continue on A27 via Arundel by-pass to <u>OFFINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where left on the A24 via Washington roundabout, Ashington and Dial Post to traffic lights at West Grinstead cross roads (which must be obeyed) continue on A24 via Southwater by-pass and Horsham by-pass to <u>BROADBRIDGE HEATH ROUNDABOUT</u> where left where left on A281 to next roundabout where straight on A281 to Roman Gate where left on A29 to Five Oaks where left on A264 to Broadbridge Heath roundabout where left on A24 to <u>WARNHAM ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace on A24 via via Broadbridge Heath roundabout, Horsham by-pass and Southwater by-pass to traffic lights (which must be obeyed) at West Grinstead cross roads to <u>JUNCTION WITH B2135</u> where left via Partridge Green and Ashurst to junction with A283 where left via roundabouts at Bramber and Beeding <u>SHOREHAM ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace on A283 to Washington roundabout where encircle to start of <u>FINISHING CIRCUIT</u> (opposite start) continue on A283 to junction with B2135 where left via Ashurst and Partridge Green with A24 where left via Dial Post and Ashington to Washington roundabout where left on A283 to complete
