The Event headquarters is situate at Ashurst Village Hall on the R2135 and the Hall will be open from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. where the result board and canteen will be located.

FOOD will be handed up at the grant and at 135 miles (bottom of the Hammerpot Hill)

DRINKS and SPONGES will be available at 25, 54, 74, 102, 121, 155, 173 miles and on the finishing circuit.

PEACHES will be handed up at 165 miles (just before Five Oaks)

BANANAS will be handed up at 182 miles (just before Ashurst)

NUMBERS will be available at the START. Please return your number to the Timekeeper at your finishing point or to any official should you retire.

PARKING. It is an R.T.T.C. District regulation that no vehicle shall be parked on the highway near the start and finish points. Helpers are reminded not to park their cars on the highway during the event so as to pose a nuisance to other road users but to park, if possible, on a verge or in a lay-by. This to be particularly observed on the finishing circuit.

RIDERS must obey the traffic lights on the Chichester By-Pass and at West Grinstead cross roads. Please remember to keep on the A27 all the way from the turn at Warblington roundabout to Offington Corner roundabout (junction with the A24). There are approximately 50 marshalls on the course and whilst every effort has been made to ensure that you have no difficulty, the onus of keeping on course rests with each rider. A few moments checking the course with a map would be worthwhile.

The chief timekeeper will close any detours as appropriate to enable all riders to reach the finishing circuit. On reaching the finishing circuit each rider will continue to the next timekweeper after his time has elapsed; the distance covered in the excess time will be deducted
