

### Notes to Marshalls

You are requested to indicate the direction to be followed but not to hold up the traffic which is an offence under the law.

Please wear a marshalls jacket. If you can't use your own Club jacket there will be a limited number available at event H.Q. Please return these as they will be needed for other Association events. You will be informed of the progress of first and last riders and when to effect cut-outs as necessary.

### Notes to Timekeepers

Please report to the Master Timekeeper at the start of the circuit at 2.30 for 3 p.m. The rendezvous is at the 'Bull' at Bethersden. Please arrange for a recorder and bring a watch. Mark on your timekeeping sheet those riders who stop at your station and return your sheet to the Master Timekeeper at the start of the circuit as soon as possible after the finish.

Endeavour to stop riders from continuing when they have completed their ride and try to give them an idea of the distance they have covered. You will be advised of riders who have lost distance around the route.

### Notes to Helpers and Spectators

A progress and result board will be at H.Q. and will show 50 and 100 mile times where appropriate.

Please do not bother timekeepers. The person completing the result board will welcome advice regarding non-finishers and actual finishing stops.

PLEASE keep out of Smarden village on the circuit. By turning left at Maltmans Hill and right at Romden Castle your rider can be picked up again at Haffenden Quarter.

### Notes to Riders

When your twelve hours have expired carry on to the next timekeeper in order that your correct distance can be calculated. Please ensure that your helpers do not follow you in cars and do not take food and drink from vehicles. Would all unnecessary vehicles keep away from the finishing circuit as it is very narrow in parts. PLEASE, when you finish make sure that your helpers do not obstruct the timekeepers view or impede other riders who are still going.

The event starts punctually, please avoid a late start.

To ensure that all riders have time to complete one lap of the circuit slower riders will be cut off legs during the day.
