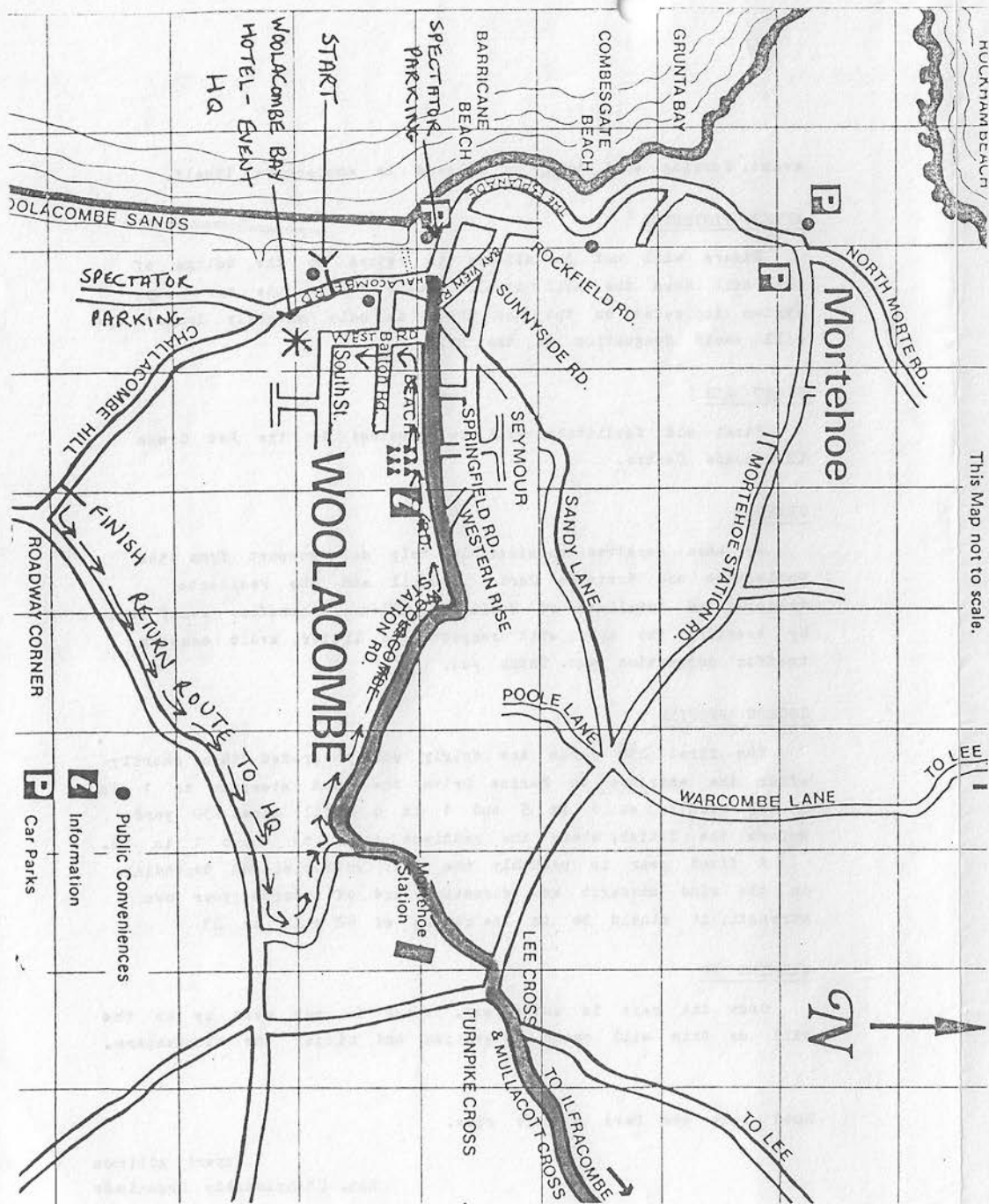

1985 NATIONAL HILL CLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP

On behalf of the Barnstaple Imperial Wheelers and the South West District Council, I welcome all competitors to the 1985 National Hill Climb Championship. I wish you all a safe and successful ride and an enjoyable day in North Devon.

ROUTES TO WOOLACOMBE

- From the M5 Motorway.
Leave the M5 at Junction 27 and follow A373, A396 and A361 signposted Barnstaple, Bideford. In Barnstaple follow A361, signposted Braunton and Ilfracombe, and continue until Mullacott Cross roundabout is reached approx. 5 miles after passing through Braunton. Take first exit onto B3343 to Woolacombe.
- From London / Southern England on A30 / A303.
Leave A30 at Honiton and take A373 (signposted Cullompton). At approach to Cullompton, turn right onto M5 (Junction 28) and proceed to Junction 27 where follow directions above.

EVENT HEADQUARTERS

Woolacombe Bay Hotel, West Road, Woolacombe.

COURSE DETAILS

START in Challacombe Road, Woolacombe, level with end of pavement approx. 10 yards past beach slipway. Proceed south-east up the hill to finish at the brow of the hill approx. 15 yards past gateway on right and approx. 100 yards before T junction with B3231.

CAR PARKING

Competitors should park in the Woolacombe Bay Hotel car park. Please display the enclosed car park pass when you arrive. Spectator parking will be in Marine Drive and along The Esplanade.

NUMBERS

These will be available at THE RACE HEADQUARTERS, where changing, washing and toilet facilities will also be available. One body and two arm numbers are to be worn by all riders. Please hand your numbers back to the steward at the conclusion of the event.

CLOTHING

When you collect your numbers you will also be handed a polythene bag with your race number on it. If you wish any warm clothing to be taken to the top of the hill for your ride back to headquarters, place it in this bag and hand it to the number steward when you leave the changing room. Your clothing will then be taken to the top of the hill and will be available immediately you finish your ride.

RESULT BOARD

This will be situated in the grounds of Woolacombe Bay Hotel. Your time will be displayed on it before you get back to headquarters, so PLEASE DO NOT BOTHER THE TIMEKEEPERS.

PRESENTATION

The presentation of the Championship award winners will be at the Result Board at approx. 12.20 pm. Ian Brass of BBC Radio Devon and Radio 1 will perform the ceremony.

AT THE FINISH

NO PARKING will be allowed along the B3231 Mullacott Cross - Croyde road in the vicinity of the finish, or on Challacombe Hill itself which will be closed for the duration of the

event. Parking will ONLY be allowed in Woolacombe itself.

AFTER FINISHING

Riders will not be allowed to return to the bottom of the hill down the hill itself. Please follow the one-way system indicated on the map which is only slightly longer and will avoid congestion on the hill.

FIRST AID

First aid facilities will be provided by the Red Cross Ilfracombe Centre.

GENERAL

We have received considerable help and support from the Woolacombe and Morteheo Parish Council and the residents, traders, and hoteliers of Woolacombe. Please therefore repay this by treating the area with respect - no litter, avoid causing traffic congestion etc. Thank you.

COURSE PROFILE

The first 250 yards are fairly easily graded, then shortly after the entrance to Marine Drive the road steepens to 1 in 5 and remains at 1 in 5 and 1 in 6 until about 50 yards before the finish, where the gradient eases to about 1 in 15.

A fixed gear is probably the most suitable, and depending on the wind strength and direction, and of course your own strength, it should be in the region of 42 x 22 or 23.

WARMING UP

Once the race is under way, please do not warm up on the hill as this will cause congestion and hinder the timekeepers.

Good luck and have a safe ride.
