SPECTATORS' INFORMATION

SATURDAY: CULVER PARADE GRANDSTAND

See the MOREYS 3 DAY competitors at 12 noon in their initial lungbursting effort to gain a lead over the others in the Prologue Time Trial. The winner will wear the MOREYS Yellow Jersey in Stage 1b at 14.30p.m. The jersey signifies that the wearer is the overall race leader and he will be trying to defend his slender lead of a few seconds while the others attack during Stage 1b in their effort to finish the Stage in front and take the jersey from him. You will see Stage 1b 7 times on its 10 mile circuit, with exciting sprints for points and time bonuses each time that it passes the Grandstand.

SUNDAY: BLACKGANG HILL; 11.30 to 14.00

The action on the famous Blackgang Hill consists of 5 laps of the MOREYS 3 DAY STAGE RACE with sprints each time for points and time bonuses, plus the CROSBY DOORS ROAD RACE which will climb the hill 3 times with a frantic finish at approx 1p.m.

CULVER PARADE GRANDSTAND; 14.30 to 16.00

See the last 2 laps of Stage 2 of the Stage Race as the exhausted riders complete a gruelling 108 mile stage.

MONDAY: CULVER PARADE GRANDSTAND; 10.00 to 16.00

Come along and cheer the MOREYS ROUND THE ISLAND TIME TRIAL competitors, who have completed 62 miles of one of the toughest and most unique time trial events in the Country, as they approach the Finish Line at the Grandstand. Then, at 12.15 you will see Stage 3 of the MOREYS STAGE RACE 20 times (every 10 minutes) as the competitors battle out the last 71 miles of this 257 mile classic, with exciting sprints every other lap.

Popular cycling commentator, ROGER SHAYES, will be giving informative and lively reports at all of these times, using information supplied to him from around the race circuits by the R.A.Y.N.E.T. radio amateur network, and a P.A. sound service supplied by buckets R.V. and Audio Service, of Lake.

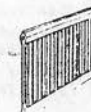

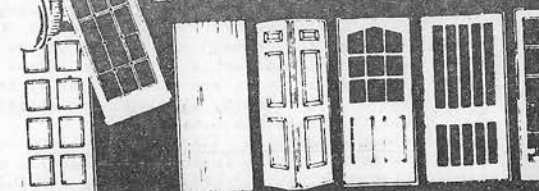

1. Collect your race number at the start, there is ample car parking behind the start or in the reserved section of the H.Q. car park at the Leisure Centre.
2. Competitors may leave belongings with the numbers clerk at the start. They will be placed in the Leisure Centre changing rooms when it opens. There will be showers in the changing rooms.
3. After finishing hand your number to the clerk at the finish line, in return for a ticket which can be exchanged for a free drink in the 'Live in' cafe.
4. PRIZE PRESENTATION is at the GRANDSTAND (Finish Line) at approx. 1p.m.
5. All finishers should claim their souvenir award after the prize presentation.
6. RACE ROUTE: Over 70 marshals and police will direct you around the course. At junctions; always follow the road you are on, unless directed off by a marshal or a Moreys arrow. All competitors must finish before 12.15 to avoid a clash with the Stage Race.

START: Sandown Pier. Proceed N.E. to the end of Sandown Esplanade and T.L.(M) into High St., to T/lights, T.L.(M) onto A3055. Follow A3055 through Lake T/lights(M), Hope Road T/lights(M), Shanklin High St. T/lights(M) 3miles, to Ventnor. Proceed through Ventnor on A3055 via hairpin bends(MM), High St., Albert St.(M), Pier St.(M) one way system. T.L.(M) via Church St, Alpine Road, Park Avenue, continuing on A3055 via St.Lawrence, Niton(M) 11miles, Chale to Freshwater Bay. S.O. to Alum Bay hairpin(M) 2miles, T.R. to Totland roundabout (M). Take 2nd exit to Yarmouth on A3054. Yarmouth Bridge T/lights (M) 30miles. Follow A3054 to Shalfleet T/lights (M), T.L.(M) at Shalfleet Garage to proceed via Porchfield, and Hillis Corner(MM) to top of Pallance Road, Northwood(M) 40miles, where T.R. onto B3325 to Northwood Garage(M), where T.R. onto A3020, via St.Marys Roundabout(M), 2nd exit to Coppins Bridge, Newport roundabout(M), 1st exit to Palmers Brook roundabout on A3054. Take 2nd exit(M), via Wootton T/lights(M), Fishbourne T/lights(M), to Hyde Queens Road T/lights(M), where T.L. to church. T.L. into one way system west St. T.R.(M) 50miles, into Lind St., T.L.(M) into St.Thomas St. to Ryae Pier, Ryde Esplanade A3055 roundabout 1st exit(M) to canoe lake, up to Bishop Lovatt Sch. and T.L.(M) into B3330. Proceed via Nettlestone to St.Helens Green. T.L.(M) into St.Helens Green Road, F.L.(M) into Latimer Road, F.L.(M) via Bembridge Harbour to Bembridge High St. T.L.(M) into Foreland Road B3395, and S.O. at Steyne Cross (M) to Yaverland T junction. 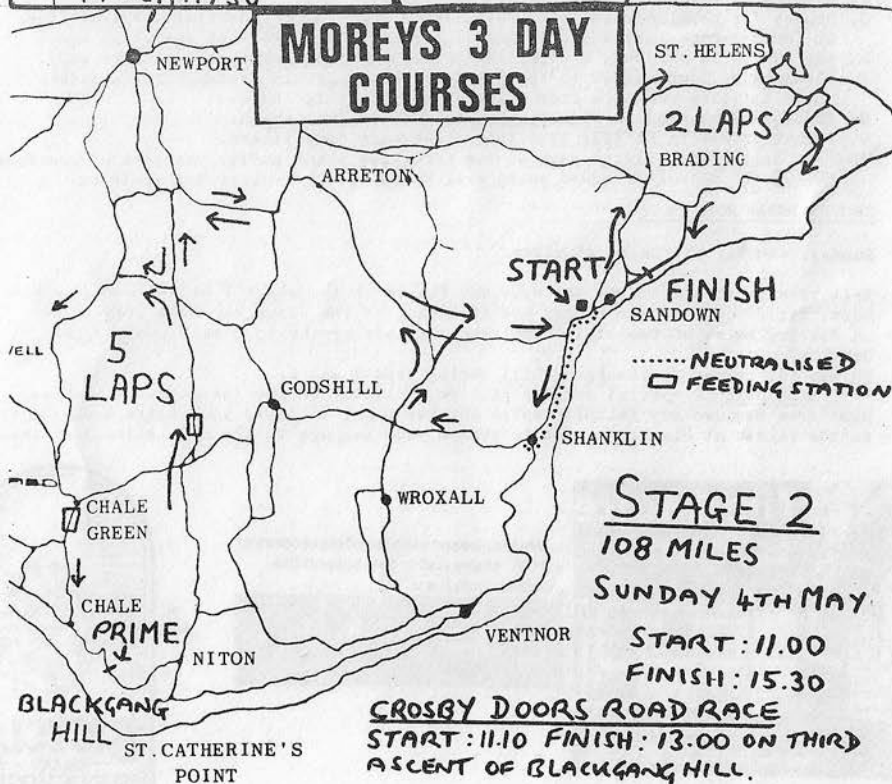
