Start on B.2026 approximately 250 yards south of stream opposite Posingford Farm entrance and 1¹/₄ miles south of Hartfield village. G.R. TQ 478341.

Proceed south to summit of climb G.R. 469312, 21 paces past drain before top car park entrance. Distance approximately 2 miles.
