Riber Hill Climb

It was in 1976 that Matlock Cycling Club member, George Higton, approached the then proprietor of the Riber Wildlife Fauna Reserve, Mr. Eddie Hallam, to discuss the possibility of holding a Hill Climb starting on the outskirts of Matlock and finishing in the grounds of Riber Castle. Mr. Hallam was enthusiastic about the possibilities and, following discussions with the Club, agreed to sponsor the event which would be known as the Riber Hill Climb.

The first event was held in 1977 with a field of forty riders and was won by Gareth Armitage in a time of 5 minutes 8.9 secs.

George Higton was also a climber of no mean ability, finishing third in 1977 and 4th in 1978. Tragically George was killed in an accident in 1979 when he was struck from behind whilst out riding his bike.

Following his untimely death, it was agreed that the event should be re-named "The George Higton Memorial Hill Climb" and a carved wooden sculpture depicting George in a hill-climbing stance was commissioned by the Club and paid for with monies raised by public subscription.

Since the change of name, which took place in 1980, the event has been won successively by Malcolm Elliot, now a successful professional, in 1980 and 1981, Dave Jarvis in 1982, Darryl Webster, one of our most successful amateurs, in 1983 and 1985, and in 1984 by current course record-holder W. P. Mansfield in a time of 5 minutes 1.7 seconds.

George Higton loved his cycling, whether racing, touring, organising, helping the youngsters or just riding his bike. He was a credit to our sport.

On the tenth anniversary of the event it is fitting that the National Hill Climb Championship of 1986 is being incorporated.
