NUMBERS - Riders will carry a body and a frame number, available at the Start. Please report five minutes earlier than starting time to collect these and fit.

LITTER - Please retain litter and drop it at the next feeding station.

RESULT BOARD - Estimated mileages will be displayed on the board at Event H.Q. DO NOT consult the Main Timekeeper.

REFRESHMENTS - From 2.p.m. at the Event H.Q. Hot and cold drinks will be available together with sandwiches, cakes, etc. Riders can exchange their body numbers for a drink. Please hand in frame numbers at the same time.

PARKING - The approach road from Nine Ashes Road to the Event H.Q. must be kept clear of vehicles.

LAST MAN - If you are <u>SURE</u> that you are the last on the road the marshals would appreciate your telling them so.

<u>LIGHTS</u> - None are Necessary

CUT OUTS - The only cut out will be at Hatfield Peverel.
