Notes to Competitors

NUMBERS - Riders will carry a body and a frame number, available at the Start. Please report five minutes earlier than starting time to collect these and fit.

MARSHALS - There should be some 50 marshals around the course. Whilst every care has been taken to ensure riders have no difficulty, the onus of keeping to the course rests with each rider.

VEHICLES - R.T.T.C. Regulation No.52 allows for assisting vehicles to be used provided these are registered with the Event Organiser prior to the start.

LITTER - Please retain litter and drop it at the next feeding station.

RESULT BOARD - Estimated mileages will be displayed on the board at Event H.Q. DO NOT consult the Main Timekeeper.

REFRESHMENTS - From 2.p.m. at the Event H.Q. Hot and cold drinks will be available together with sandwiches, cakes, etc. Riders can exchange their body numbers for a drink. Please hand in frame numbers at the same time.

PARKING - The approach road from Nine Ashes Road to the Event H.Q. must be kept clear of vehicles.

LAST MAN - If you are SURE that you are the last on the road the marshals would appreciate your telling them so.

LIGHTS - None are Necessary

CUT OUTS - The only cut out will be at Hatfield Peverel. Riders will be cut from circuit - Hatfield Peverel, Heybridge, Stanway in sufficient time to allow them to reach finishing circuit and complete one lap at least. Estimated completions of large circuit shown beside name on starting order. Cut out will be controlled by Messrs A.Osborne & A.Deuters.

Proceed East, at 1st Roundabout($4\frac{1}{2}$ m)(M.1) take 1st EXIT, at next R.A.B. S/O towards WRITTLE. to Beddels End, where left onto A1060(M.2) 6.45 6.45
Right(Great Care) at Leaden Roding into B184(M.3). Continue to Dunmow to TURN CLOCKWISE round Green Triangle at Clopton Hall Lane(M.4) 12.71 19.16
Retrace to Beddels End(M.5) 12.69 31.85
