Firstly many many thanks to all the TIMEKEEPERS and the army of MARSHALS and helpers. NOT ONE DNS!!


A 12 hour event was a new experience to many of those involved, both riding & helping. Even some of the 'old hands' had to dig deep to recall all the procedures.
