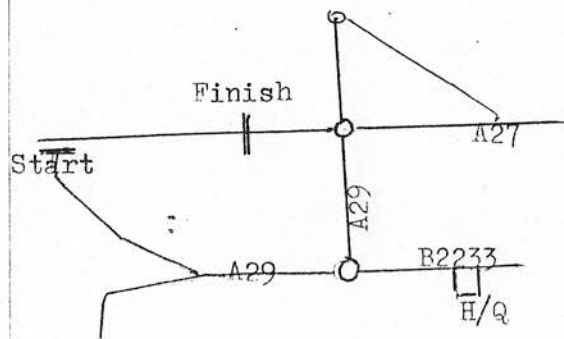
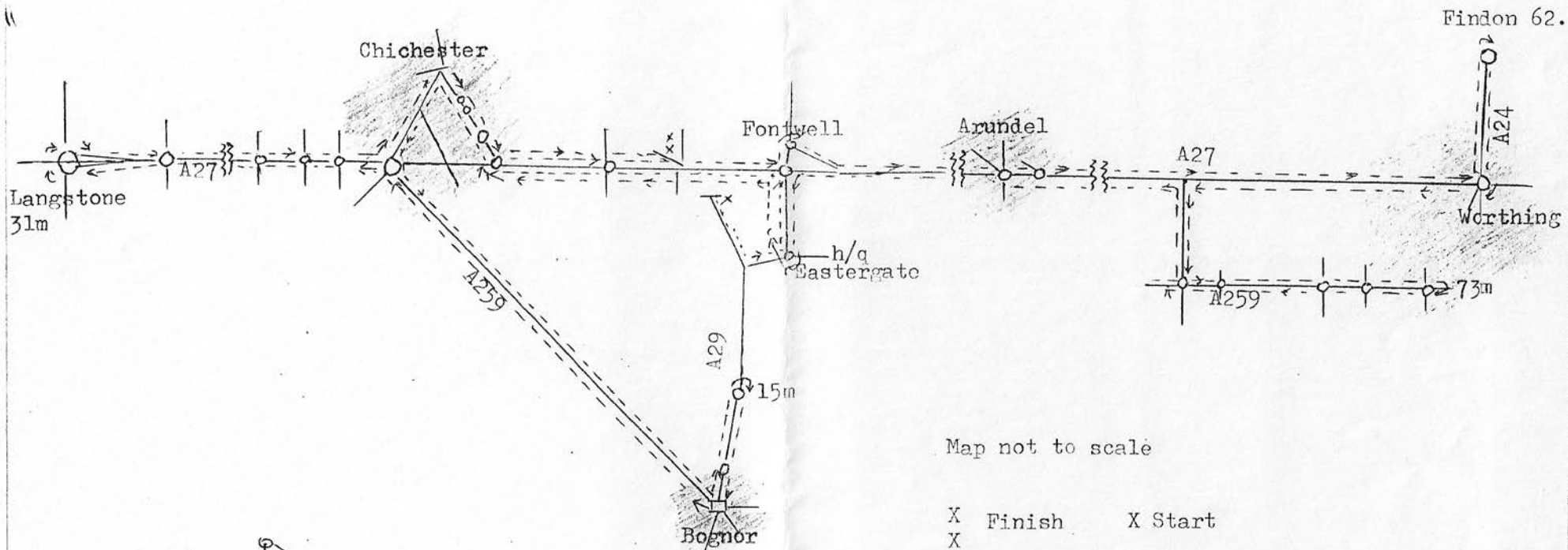

<p><u>START</u> (Map Ref.) at junction of A27/B2233 at Crocker Hill by road sign teading "East Hampnett $\frac{1}{2}$ mile" proceed in a south easterly direction to junction with A29 where left to Eastergate Lion RAB where left continuing on A29 to junction with A27 at Fontwell South RAB where left on A27 in a westerly direction via Tangmere RAB to <u>Westhampnett RAB</u> where take second exit into Chichester continue straight on past Sainsburys RAB and two mini roundabouts to the Needlemakers one way system where bear left on the A259 over railway bridge to Bognor Bridge RAB where take second exit continuing on the A259 to large roundabout in Bognor where take the first exit on the A29 to the second roundabout at Rowans Way where <u>TURN</u> (Map Ref 940015) and retrace on the A29 to large roundabout at Bognor where bear right on the A259 to Bognor Bridge RAB where take the second exit on to the A27 where left through roundabouts at Whyke, Selsey Road, Bosham and Emsworth to Havant By-pass take slip road underneath Fly-over at Langstone RAB (care) where <u>TURN</u> rejoining the A27 and retrace in a easterly via all roundabouts to Bognor Bridge RAB where take the first exit on to the A259 to Chichester city centre keeping to the right hand lane one way system and take the A285 to <u>Westhampnett RAB</u> take the second exit on to the A27 where continue in an easterly direction via roundabouts at Tangmere, South and North Fontwell and Arundel By-pass to <u>Offington RAB</u> where left on the A24 (care) where continue in a northerly direction to <u>TURN</u> at Findon RAB where encircle and retrace to Offington RAB where take the fourth exit on to the A27 to the junction with the A280 at Patching where left through Angmering village to Angmering RAB where left on the A259 via roundabouts at Roundstone and Goring where the A259 goes right but continue straight on A2032 via West Durrington roundabout to East Durrington RAB to <u>TURN</u> (by Gateway Building Society Offices) where encircle and retrace to Angmering RAB where bear right taking the third exit on the A280 to junction with A27 at Patching where left continuing in an westerly direction via Arundel By-pass to turn off the A27 into Fontwell village where left at Fontwell South RAB on to the A29 to <u>TURN</u> at Eastergate Lion RAB where encircle (care) and retrace to Fontwell South RAB where left on the A27 via Tangmere RAB to Westhampnett RAB where <u>TURN</u> encircle and retrace eastwards on the A27 to <u>FINISH</u> (Map ref 939072) at point opposite small A.A. telephone box approximately 20 yards short of junction with Brittens Lane</p>	<p>7.573 miles 20</p> <p>15.157 " 40</p> <p>31.472 " 1-25</p> <p>44.229 " 2-00</p> <p>60.273 "</p> <p>62.545 " 2-48</p> <p>73.593 " 3-18</p> <p>90.209 " 4-03</p> <p>96.013 " 4-20</p> <p>100.000 " 4-30</p>

NUMBERS

These will be available at the start

DRINKS & SPONGES

These will be handed up at approximately 48,55,80 and 92 miles. Peaches will be handed up at approximately 75 miles
Owing to the withdrawal of sponsorship this year we regret we are unable to have food available at the start or en route. Riders are requested to make their own arrangements

THE COURSE

Riders are urged to take great care at the road works at Fontwell and at Offington RAB and at the turn at eastergate Lion RAB (90m)
The Police have requested that great care be taken on the single carriage way sections of the A27 west of Chichester. Any careless or foolhardy riding could jeopardize the use of this course in the future
Where there are no marshals at roundabouts on the A27 riders should continue straight on

R.T.T.C

It is a district regulation that no vehicle shall be parked on the carriage way within sight of the starting or finishing points
Regulation 49 (Observance of the law) and Regulation 50 (Paced and Company Riding) will be strictly enforced

EVENT H/Q

This is located at Eastergate Village Hall on B2233 approximately 500 yards east of Eastergate Lion RAB
Food and refreshments will be available. The Result Board will also be here. Riders are advised not to leave any money or valuables in the hall as it will be un-attended during part of the morning. The hall will be opened at 5 a.m.

PARKING

There is ample room for parking at the rear of the hall and at the finish. Cars parking at the finish are asked not to park in front of the A.A. Box leaving sufficient space for the time keepers car.
